Dept.-Engineering Office, City Property Section, Plan No. 061241, Date July 18, 1955" have ceased to be useful to the public and the same are abandoned as highways and the damage to the abutters is appraised at nothing and so awarded and it is further

ORDERED That the Superintendent of Street Signs and Numbers be and he is hereby directed to cause a sign to be placed at the northerly end of Gibbs Court and at each end of Grady Lane and at the westerly end of Paca Place and Robinson Street, abandoned as aforesaid, having thereon the words, "Not a Public Highway" and it is further

ORDERED, That after the entry of this order or decree the City Clerk shall cause a notice thereof to be published in a newspaper published in the County of Providence, at least once each week for three successive weeks and a further and personal notice shall be served by the City Sergeant upon every owner of land abutting upon Gibbs Court, Grady Lane, Paca Place and Robinson Street which have been abandoned, who is known to reside within this State.




