Dear Sirs:

We presently live on 322 Taber Ave. Providence since May 1, 1976. We would like to apply ^{petition} for approval to do sandblasting.

The front of the house is partly brick (about 100 sq ft.) The previous owner of the house had painted the brick surface with white paint which has been peeling over the years of abandoned condition. As it is, the house presents a detrimental sight in the well-kept neighborhood, and we feel that an urgent improvement of this condition is required.

Fortunately the portion which needs to be sandblasted (to peel off the old paint from the brick surface) is very small ^{and} can be done in half a day or so, according to a candid remark of one of the contractors.

The condition requires sandblasting whatever we decide to do to the brick wall since new paint would not have adhered to it even if we ^{had} ~~have~~ tried to paint it over. ~~Presently~~ We intend to leave ^{the} natural brick surface after the sandblasting.
