


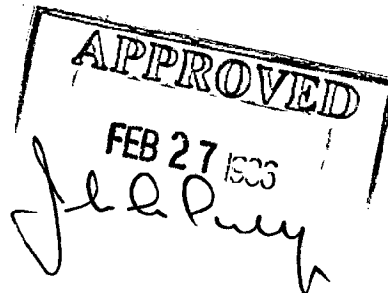
WHEREAS, The City of Providence is undertaking a review and study of tax-exempt institutions, and
