

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 455

Approved November 20, 1972

WHEREAS, a Resolution of the City Council establishing Young Avenue, from Smith Street to Chalkstone Avenue, as a one-way street was introduced into the City Council on November 18, 1971, and referred to the Committee on Public Works, and

WHEREAS, on November 18, 1971, a copy of the subject Resolution was referred to the Traffic Engineer for study and report, and

WHEREAS, again, on April 17, 1972, the sponsors of that Resolution, Councilman Ahern and Councilman Crowley, at the request of residents of the area for consideration of that Resolution, requested a response from the Traffic Engineer and, accordingly, a second memorandum was transmitted to the Traffic Engineer, and

WHEREAS, as of this date, being October 13, 1972, the original Resolution has not been reported on,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that Young Avenue, from Smith Street to Chalkstone Avenue, is established as a one-way street notwithstanding the benefit of a report from the Traffic Engineer.
