AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 2-99 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE ENTITLED, "AUTHORITY DELEGATED TO CITY SOLICITOR TO SETTLE SMALL CLAIMS ", AS AMENDED.

Approved September 9, 1994

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

SECTION 1. Section 2-99 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Providence entitled, "Authority delegated to city solicitor to settle small claims against the city, " is hereby amended to read as follows:

SEC. 2-99. AUTHORITY DELEGATED TO CITY SOLICITOR TO SETTLE SMALL CLAIMS AGAINST THE CITY

The city solicitor shall have the authority and power delegated to him and his office to settle claims against the city for damages and injuries due to, or occasioned by, the negligence of the city or any officer, agent, or employee of the city without the necessity of the approval of the mayor and the chairman of the Committee on Claims and Pending Suits in claims or actions in litigation before the courts not to exceed Three Thousand Dollars (\$3,000.00). At any time when the city solicitor shall exercise the authority and power delegated to him under this ordinance he shall report the disposition to the Committee on Claims and Pending Suits.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.

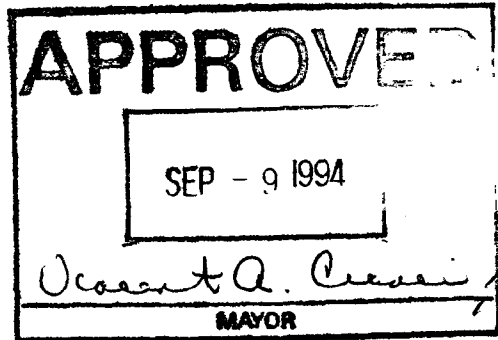
