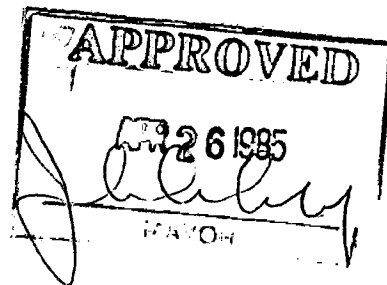
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the City Council of the City of Providence hereby endorses House Bill 85-H 5751.

RELATING TO PROPERTY TAX ADMINISTRATION

It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The general assembly hereby appropriates to the city
2 of Providence out of any money in the treasury not otherwise appropri-
3 ated for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1985, the sum of fifty thou-
4 sand dollars (\$50,000.00), pursuant to the provisions of section
5 44-5-11.4 entitled "Property tax assessment -- Technology grants," to
6 establish and implement a model computer demonstration program for the
7 purposes of city and town property tax administration, and the state
8 controller is hereby authorized and directed to draw his orders upon
9 the general treasurer for the payment of such sum or so much thereof
10 as may be required upon receipt by him of proper vouchers approved by
11 the director of community affairs.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
