That the following named street shown as cross-hatched area on the accompanying plan entitled, "Providence, Rhode Island, Department of Public Works - Engineering Office, Street Line Section Plan No. 063969, dated May 26, 1976",

viz:

Crout Street (portion of) shown as cross-hatched area (A-B-C-D-A), having ceased to be useful to the Public and the same is hereby abandoned as a Public Highway and the damage to the abutters is appraised at nothing, and so awarded, subject to those easements incorporated in accompanying correspondence, June 10, 1980 from City Engineer, a copy of which is hereto attached, also correspondence, June 11, 1980 from the Acting Chief Engineer of Water Supply Board, a copy of which is hereto attached,

ORDERED, That the Director of Public Works, be and he is hereby directed to cause a sign to be placed on the above-named street abandoned as aforesaid, having thereon the words, "Not a Public Highway", and it is further

ORDERED, That after the entry of this order or decree, the City Clerk shall cause a notice, thereof, to be published in a newspaper published in the County of Providence at least once a week for three successive weeks, and a further and personal notice shall be served by the City Sergeant upon every owner of land abutting the above-named highway which has been abandoned, who is known to reside within the State.

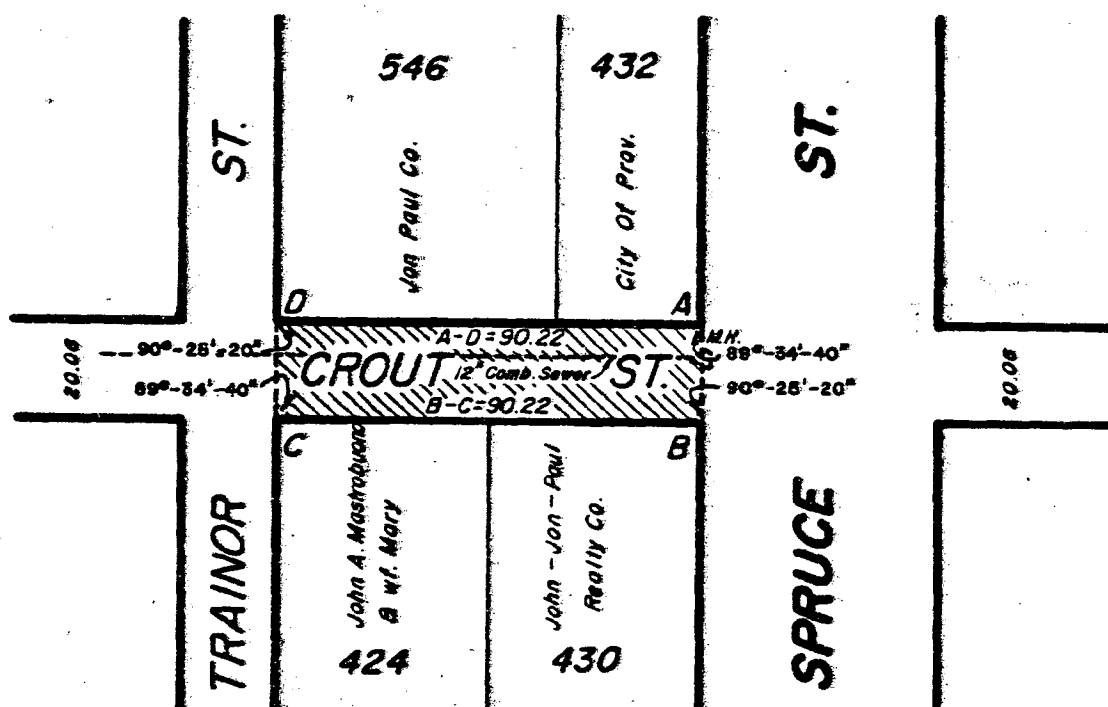


Lot Numbers From Assessor's Plat 28


On June 9, 1980 this department received a memorandum and copy of a Petition to abandon as a public highway that portion of Crout Street between Spruce and Trainor Street.

Gentlemen:

The City Plan Commission at its June 24, 1980 regular monthly meeting reevaluated the subject petition proposed to abandon the portion of Crout Street between Spruce and Trainor Streets. This petition was submitted to the City Council by John W. Mastrobuono and Paul E. Mastrobuono.

A field inspection revealed that portion of Crout Street is an improved public right-of-way and it is a narrow roadway with a 20 ft. width including sidewalks. All parcels fronting that portion of Crout Street in question have egress on adjoining streets (Spruce and Trainor Sts.). The surrounding area is mixed commercial, industrial and residential and is in generally fair to poor condition within the "Federal Hill East" urban renewal project.

This narrow street has no important value as a thoroughfare but is a service road to the adjoining properties. The petitioners, John Mastrobuono and Paul Mastrobuono, own three of the four lots (Lots 414, 432 and 546) adjoining the street in question. There are utility lines under the street (8" combination storm and sanitary sewer, 6" cast iron water pipe). Therefore, if all easements (if any) made necessary by the utility lines are granted and other abutting property owners offer no objection, the Department of Planning and Urban Development will have no objection to the proposed abandonment.

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



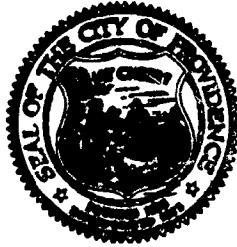
