No. 208 AN ORDINANCE

An Ordinance in amendment of and in addition to Chapter 1575 of the ordinances of the City of Providence entitled "An ordinance approving and adopting the Official Redevelopment Plan for the Weybosset Hill Project No. R.I. R-7."

Approved June 10, 1970

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

1. That Chapter 1575 of the Ordinance of the City of Providence, entitled "An Ordinance approving and adopting the Official Redevelopment Plan for the Weybosset Hill Project No. R.I. R-7" as heretofore amended, be and is hereby further amended as follows:

A. Parcel No. 9, (b) Accessory Uses, (Page 17 of the Official Redevelopment Plan) Add the following paragraph

((4)) Professional and institutional offices shall be permitted on the ground floor and the floor immediately above it provided an exception is granted by the Zoning Board of Review, otherwise, all such activity shall be conducted on the ground floor only in compliance with the zoning ordinance.

Other non-residential uses as approved by the Providence Redevelopment Agency and permitted by the zoning ordinance will be permitted. These uses are permitted provided that there is no manufacturing or processing of materials in connection with the uses.

B. Parcel No. 9, Building Controls, (Page 17 of the Official Redevelopment Plan) Delete sections (d), (e), (g) and (i) and insert the following instead:

(d) Height: Maximum 110 ft. to top of building parapet

(e) Setback: A 10 foot setback will be required along the full frontage of Fountain Street to respect a utility easement. Setback not to be less than 5 feet along the full frontage of Washington Street.

(g) On-Site Parking: As required by zoning ordinance of the City of Providence.

(i) Planning & Design Objectives: The creation and the delimitation of the open space in which is sited the elevator apartment building (Parcel No. 8), and the channeling of this space down the Jackson Street Public Walkway toward Cathedral Square.

2. That said Chapter 1575 of the Ordinances of the City of Providence as adopted and as heretofore amended, be and the same is hereby ratified and affirmed in all other respects.

3. That this ordinance shall take effect on its passage and shall be filed with the City Clerk who is hereby authorized and directed to forward a certified copy thereof to the Providence Redevelopment Agency.

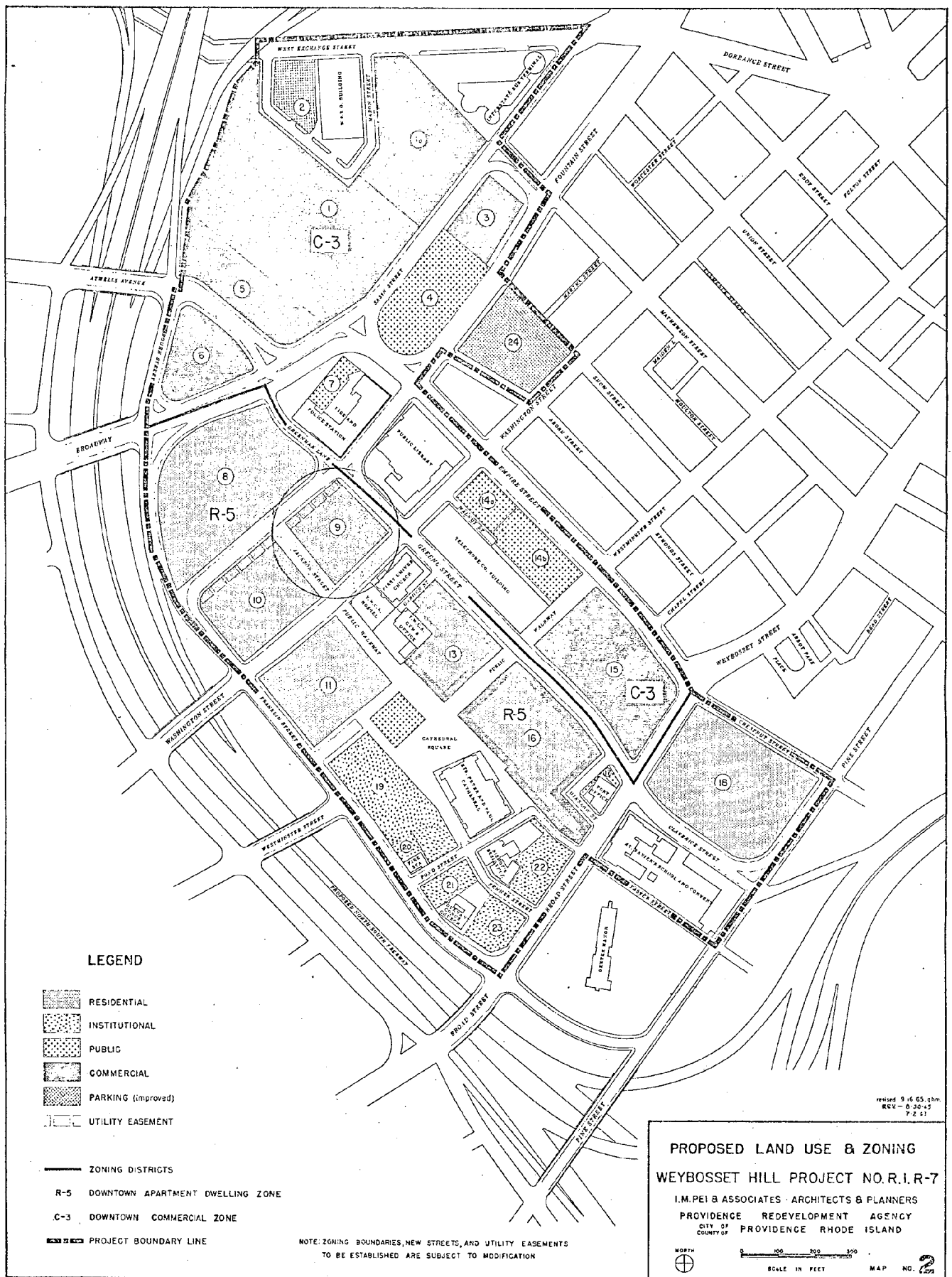

Plan for the Weybosset Hill Project R.I. R-7

Dear Mr. Vespia:

The Providence Redevelopment Agency at its meeting of March 24, 1970, approved a site plan for Parcel 9 within the Weybosset Hill Project that requires certain amendments to the Official Redevelopment Plan for said project.

The proposed development for said Parcel 9 of 37,631 sq. ft. envisions a 12 story building, including 10 stories of residential and 2 lower levels of professional and institutional office space. Envisioned on this site are 120 dwelling units, 18,000 sq. ft. of office space, and underground and surface parking.

Major changes to the Plan are the provision of professional and institutional office space on the two lower floors of the building; an increase in height from 100 feet to 110 feet; and removal of the one off-street parking space for each dwelling unit to that imposed by the zoning ordinance.

Minor changes in building setback relate to design objectives and are not in conflict with the existing zoning ordinance.


The attached proposed ordinance setting forth the aforesaid requested amendments and proposed land use map citing the location

RESOLVED,
