RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 703

Approved December 29, 1997

WHEREAS, An Ordinance appropriating \$50 million and authorizing issuance of \$50 million in bonds for the Neighborhood Improvement Program: A Plan to Revitalize Providence's Neighborhoods was adopted (1997-27); and;

WHEREAS, said Ordinance requires that "each component of said plan will be developed and approved by the City Council prior to the expenditures of any funds"; and;

WHEREAS, \$10,594,685 million has been appropriated by Council Resolution No. 375 dated June 30, 1997, Council Resolution No. 474 dated August 22, 1997 and Council Resolution No. 610 dated October 19, 1997 for various projects; and;

WHEREAS, plans have been developed for additional components of the Neighborhood Improvement Plan;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the following expenditure of funds are approved:

1. Mt. Pleasant Little League - \$150,000

1. Removal of Diseased Street Trees - \$40,000

1. Property Acquisition – Public St. & Prairie Ave. - \$33,100
