

DOG OFFICER CITY OF PROVIDENCE

SUBJECT: ORDER TO CEASE AND DESIST AND ABATE AN ANIMAL NUISANCE

WHEREAS the provisions of Section 17, sub section (a) of Chapter 68-41 of the Ordinances of the City of Providence makes it unlawful for a resident of the City of Providence to keep or harbor any dog or any other animal, whether licensed or not, which by reason of habitual howling, yelping, barking or other noise disturbs three or more persons having separate residence, or three or more persons regularly employed in the neighborhood, in said City of Providence and WHEREAS the provisions of Section 17, sub section (b) of said ordinance makes it unlawful for an owner or custodian of any dog or other animal to allow or permit said dog or other animal to trespass on private or public property so as to damage or destroy any property or thing of value, or is vicious or in any manner causes undue annoyance to said residents or persons regularly employed in the neighborhood and WHEREAS three or more persons having separate residence in said City of Providence in accordance with Section 17, sub section (a) and (b) of said Ordinance have alleged in writing and do make complaint to the Dog Officer of said City of Providence that an animal Sheep MONG and

and WHEREAS the Dog Officer L M Cross of said City of Providence is in receipt of this written allegation and by investigation finds such nuisance to exist, and WHEREAS in accordance with the authority granted the Dog Officer by the provisions of Section 17, sub section (b) of said ordinance, as owner or custodian of said animal _____

are hereby ordered by said dog officer to immediately cease, desist and abate said nuisance. Failure to comply with this order shall require the dog officer to impound said animal and summons the owner or custodian of said animal before the Municipal Court of the City of Providence for a hearing.
