## CHAPTER 1993-58

No. 854 AN ORDINANCE REGULATING GRAFFITI

Approved December 27, 1993

*Be it ordained by the City of Providence:*

SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful for any person without the expressed consent of the owner of the subject property to daub, scratch, write or otherwise injure with paint or similar materials, blacken, caulk or in any other way or manner deface any post, lamppost, fence, tree, tree box, dwelling or other building situated on or upon any street, highway, bridge, way public or private, place or ground set apart for public purpose in the City or any ornament or appurtenance of such post, lamppost, fence, tree, tree box, dwelling or other building.

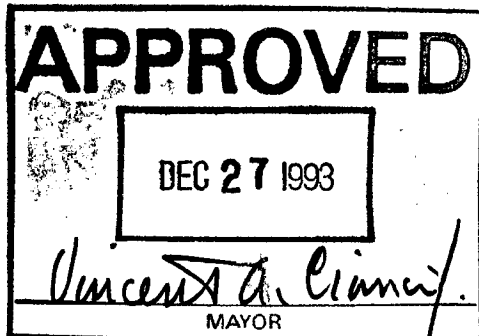
SECTION 2. Any person who commits any of the aforesaid offenses shall be punished by a fine of not less than two hundred dollars (\$200.00) and one hundred twenty (120) hours of community service. Such community service shall be completed by the removal of litter, painting of community lots and the general restoration of public grounds.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.
