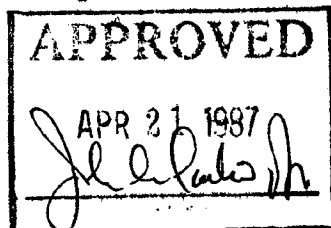

At a meeting of the Zoning Board of Review held on Monday, October 6, 1986, the following Resolution was adopted:

WHEREAS; Fairview, Inc., Owner, and Shell Oil Company, applicant and lessee, filed an application for permission to be relieved from Sections 23-A-3a, 44-A, 54-A-3(1) and 54-A-3(3) under Sections 91 and 92 of the Zoning Ordinance in the proposed installation of three new 12,000 gallon underground gasoline storage tanks bringing total storage to 36,000 gallons at 152-162 Angell Street, Lot 656 on Assessor's Plat 10 in a Commercial C-4 & Residence R-4 Zone. The lot in question contains approximately 16,122 sq. ft. of land area; and


WHEREAS; on Friday, October 3, 1986, members of the Zoning Board of Review made an inspection of the above-described premises and also of the surrounding properties and noted that premises are surrounded by commercial and institutional uses; and

WHEREAS; a public hearing was held on this application by the Zoning Board of Review at its meeting held on Monday, October 6, 1986, after public notice as provided by the Zoning Ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, after consideration of the application and testimony of the applicant and real estate expert, and after having carefully weighed the same, the Zoning Board of Review hereby grants the following:

RESOLVED: That the Zoning Board of Review does hereby make a variance of Sections 23-A-3a, 44-A, 54-A-3(1) and 54-A-3(3) under Sections 91 & 92 of the Zoning Ordinance and does hereby grant the application of Fairview, Inc., owner, and Shell Oil Company, applicant and lessee, substantially in accordance with the plans and plot plans filed with said Board provided that no additional pumps are installed. A copy of said plans and plot plans are hereby made a part of this Resolution and filed with the Director of the Department of Inspection and Standards. The above is granted as per amended application.

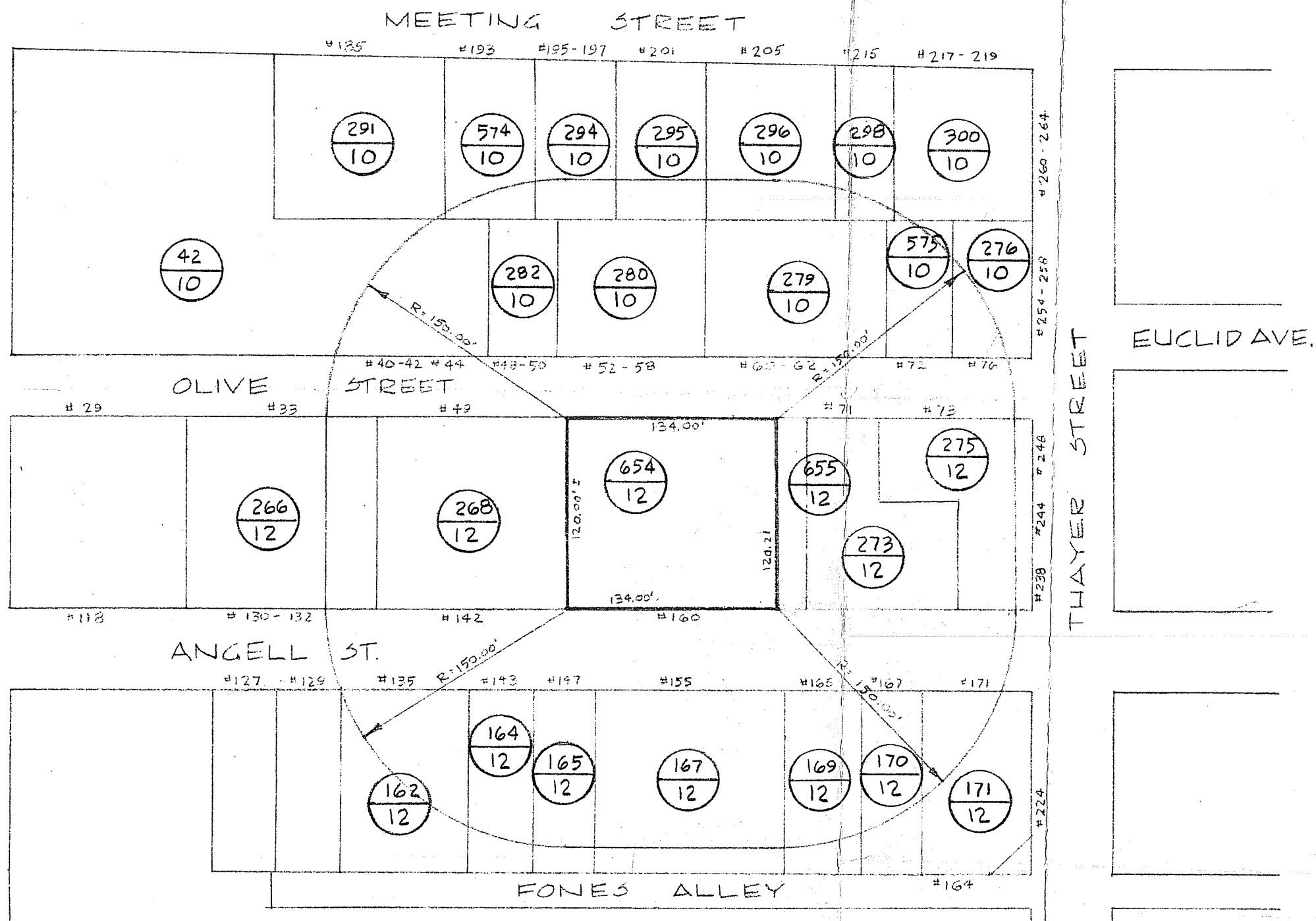

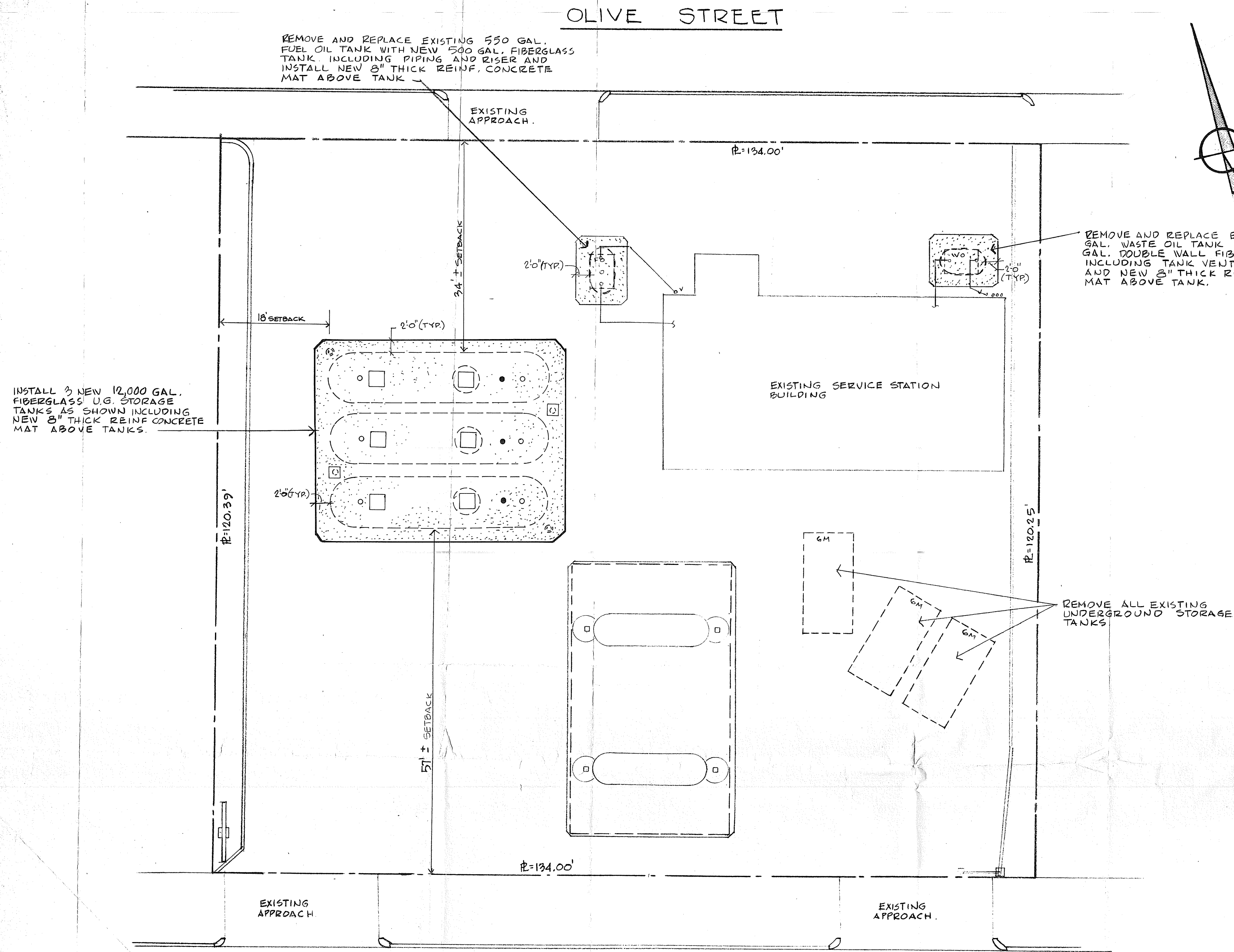

- Steel wear plates, with a minimum dimension of 8" x 8" x 1/4" thick, will be provided below and centered under all tank openings.
- New tanks shall have submerged fill tubes.
- New tanks shall be factory tested at a minimum of 5 PSI and guaranteed tight by the manufacturer.
- There shall be a continuous monitoring system installed. It shall be a Gilbarco Tank Monitor or approved equal.
- The remote pump delivery piping systems shall be equipped with a line leak detection system.
- The product delivery system will be pressure tested at 150% of the working capacity (minimum of 50 PSI).
- The terminus of remote piping system will have an emergency shutoff valve at the base of the dispensing unit to shut off product flow.
- Observation wells will be installed as required by section 10 h1 and 10 h2 of the "Regulations for Underground Storage Facilities Used for Petroleum Products and Hazardous Materials."
- Fiberglass piping is to be used. Where changes in direction occur normally requiring swing-joints, 1 1/2"x24" underground flexible connectors with Teflon spiral tube and braided stainless steel jacket will be used.
