


RESOLVED, that the Traffic Engineer is requested to cause the installation of a "Driveway" Sign along the easterly side of Opper Street, near Nahant Street.






Gentlemen:

The Traffic Engineering Department has received the following resolution from your Committee and has taken the subsequent action:

Request: That the Traffic Engineer is requested to cause the installation of a "Driveway" sign along the easterly side of Opper Street near Nahant Street.

Disposition: It has not been the policy of this department to install such signs. This is a city street with many driveways. Operators of motor vehicles should use caution upon entering a roadway. There is no reason for special treatment of this one particular driveway.
