WHEREAS, The City currently mails out tax bills quarterly and does not use a lock box, and



WHEREAS, By not using a lock box, the City loses interest on the days in which the money is not deposited, and


WHEREAS, One days interest on \$25 Million Dollars at 4% is approximately \$3,000.00, and

WHEREAS, The City mailed out approximately 300,000 tax bills in the 2nd, 3rd and 4th quarters at a cost of \$.25 each or \$75,000.00, and

WHEREAS, Coupon books have proved successful for people with mortgages and car loans,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the City Collector study the feasibility of using a lock box and coupon books versus quarterly mailings of tax bills.
