No. 136 **AN ORDINANCE** IN AMENDMENT OF CHAPTER 544 OF THE ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE, APPROVED SEPTEMBER 21, 1951, AS HERETOFORE AMENDED, IS HEREBY FURTHER AMENDED BY CHANGING FROM AN R-3 GENERAL RESIDENTIAL ZONE TO A C-1 LIMITED COMMERCIAL ZONE, LOT 653 AS SET OUT AND DELINEATED ON CITY ASSESSOR'S PLAT 104; SAID LOT BEING LOCATED ON THE NORTHERLY SIDE OF UNION AVENUE AND DESIGNATED AS 205 UNION AVENUE.

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

SECTION 1: The Zoning Map accompanying and made a part of Chapter 544 of the Ordinances of the City of Providence, approved September 21, 1951, as heretofore amended, and entitled "An Ordinance Zoning the City of Providence and Establishing Use, Height and Area Regulations" is hereby further amended by changing from an R-3 General Residential Zone to a C-1 Limited Commercial Zone, Lot 653 as set out and delineated on City Assessor's Plat 104; said lot being located on the northerly side of Union Avenue and designated as 205 Union Avenue, bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the northerly line of Union Avenue at the southwesterly corner of Lot 653 on Assessor's Plat 104; thence northerly along the easterly line of Lot 590 to the northwesterly corner of Lot 653; thence easterly along the southerly line of Lot 652 to the northeasterly corner of Lot 653; thence southerly along the westerly line of Lot 654 to the northerly line of Union Avenue and the southeasterly corner of Lot 653; thence westerly along the northerly line of Union Avenue to the southwesterly corner of Lot 653 and the point and place of beginning.

SEC. 2: This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.

This referral is a request for a change of zoning from an R-3 Zone to an M-1 Zone Lot 653 on Assess's Plat 104 located at 205 Union Avenue.

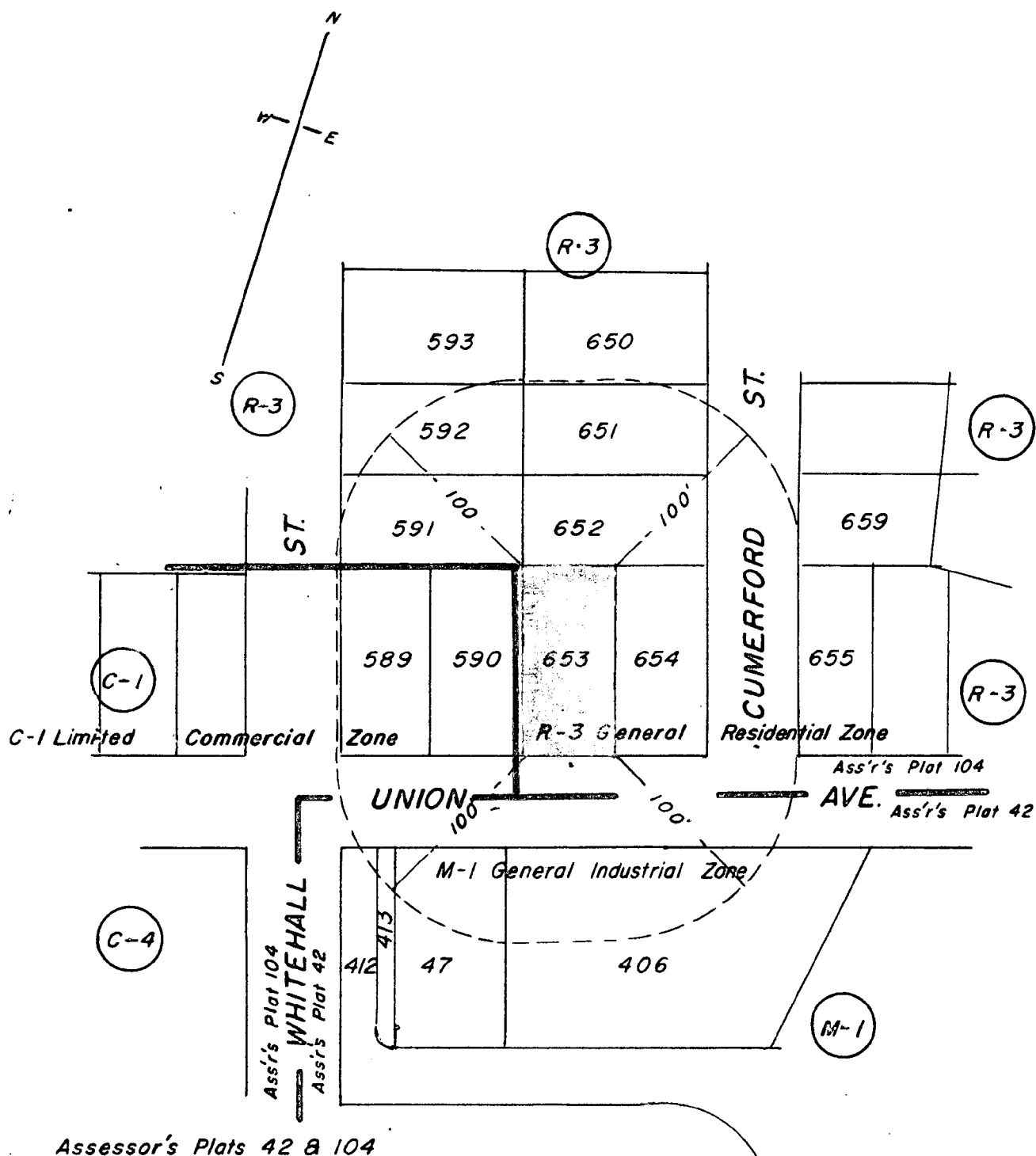

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

SECTION 1. Chapter 1143 of the Ordinances of the City of Providence, as approved September 20, 1957, entitled: "An Ordinance Making Appropriation of \$36,161,545.40 for the support of the City Government for the Fiscal Year Ending September 30, 1958", as amended, is hereby further amended by appropriating the sum of Thirty Five Thousand (\$35,000) Dollars to General Public Assistance - Administration, Item 1.

SECTION 2. The said sum of Thirty Five Thousand (\$35,000) Dollars as thus added and appropriated shall be obtained by authorizing and directing the City Controller and the City Treasurer to transfer a like amount from the Reserve for Extraordinary Expenditures to the Receipt Account.

SECTION 3. The estimated receipts from the Reserve for Extraordinary Expenditures are hereby increased by Thirty Five Thousand (\$35,000) Dollars.

SECTION 1: Section 26 A 5 of Chapter 544 of the Ordinances of the City of Providence, approved September 21, 1951, as amended, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"5. Corner Setback -- In all zones except the C-3 Zone, in the triangle formed by the lines of streets intersecting at an angle of less than one hundred thirty five (135) degrees and a line joining points on such lines fifteen (15) feet distant from their point of intersection no building or structure may be erected and no vegetation may be maintained between heights of three and one-half (3½) feet and ten (10) feet above the plane through their curb grades. Notwithstanding the provisions of this section, poles not exceeding eight (8) inches in outside diameter (designed for the support of lights and signs, may be erected in this triangle."

SEC. 2: This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.

Notwithstanding the provisions of this section, poles not exceeding eight (8) inches in outside diameter designed for the support of lights and signs, may be erected in this triangle."
