EFFECTIVE July 26, 2021

WHEREAS, Access to the shoreline is a historically important, and legally protected, right for all Rhode Islanders and, as the Ocean State, it is imperative that state and local governments continue to enforce the public's right to such access; and

WHEREAS, There has recently been an issue regarding a section of Public Street and whether or not it is a recognizes right-of-way for purposes of shoreline access to the general public; and



WHEREAS, The Coastal Resource Management Council is now in the process of considering a formal designation of Public Street as an official right-of-way for purposes of shoreline access.
