RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 840

Approved November 13, 1975

WHEREAS, death has claimed the life of Ugo Riccio, late a Member of the Water Supply Board of the City of Providence, Rhode Island, who has served in that capacity from March 18, 1948, and

WHEREAS, Mr. Riccio, was a Member of that Board during the period when the expansion of the Water Supply Board's System was increased from an average, daily 3,700,000.00 gallons consumption to 63,700,000.00 gallons and extended its service to include Kent County, the City of East Providence, the western portion of the City of Cranston, and the towns of Greenville and Smithfield, and

WHEREAS, the income revenue from this well-renowned City facility, was increased from \$2,700,000.00 to \$4,900,000.00 in the last immediate year,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that in noting the passing of Ugo Riccio, His Honor Mayor Vincent A. Cianci, Jr., and the Members of the City Council pause in tribute to his memory and in appreciation of his more than one quarter of a century of service as a member of the Water Supply Board of the City of Providence.
