## CHAPTER 1489

No. 255AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE APPROPRIATION  
ORDINANCE, CHAPTER 1489, BY APPROPRIATING THE  
SUM OF TWO HUNDRED FIFTY (\$250.00) DOLLARS TO  
THE RHODE ISLAND STATE DEPARTMENT, FRANCO-AMERICAN  
WAR VETERANS, INC., CONVENTION COMMITTEE.

*Be it ordained by the City of Providence:*

SECTION 1. Chapter 1489 of the Ordinances of the City of Providence as approved September 21, 1962, entitled: "An Ordinance Making Appropriation of \$43,334,668.75 for the Support of the City Government for the Fiscal Year Ending September 30, 1963", as amended, is hereby further amended by appropriating the sum of Two Hundred Fifty (\$250.00) Dollars to the RHODE ISLAND STATE DEPARTMENT, FRANCO-AMERICAN WAR VETERANS, INC., CONVENTION COMMITTEE.

SECTION 2. The money hereby appropriated shall be paid to the Treasurer of the 1963 Rhode Island State Department, Franco-American War Veterans, Inc., Convention Committee to help defray the expenses of the Department Convention to be held in the City of Providence on June 7th, 8th and 9th, 1963.

SECTION 3. The said sum of Two Hundred Fifty (\$250.00) Dollars as hereby appropriated shall be obtained by authorizing and directing the City Controller and City Treasurer to transfer a like amount from the Reserve for Extraordinary Expenditures Account to the Receipt Account.

SECTION 4. The estimated receipts from Reserve for Extraordinary Expenditures are hereby increased by the sum of Two Hundred Fifty (\$250.00) Dollars.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.

SECTION 1. Chapter 1490 of the Ordinances of the City of Providence, approved September 21, 1962, as amended, is hereby further amended, to read as follows:

That part which has heretofore read: "The number of employees in the POLICE DEPARTMENT shall not exceed seven hundred eleven (711)"; shall hereafter read: "The number of employees in the POLICE DEPARTMENT shall not exceed seven hundred twelve (712)".

Add: (1) SCHOOL CROSSING GUARD

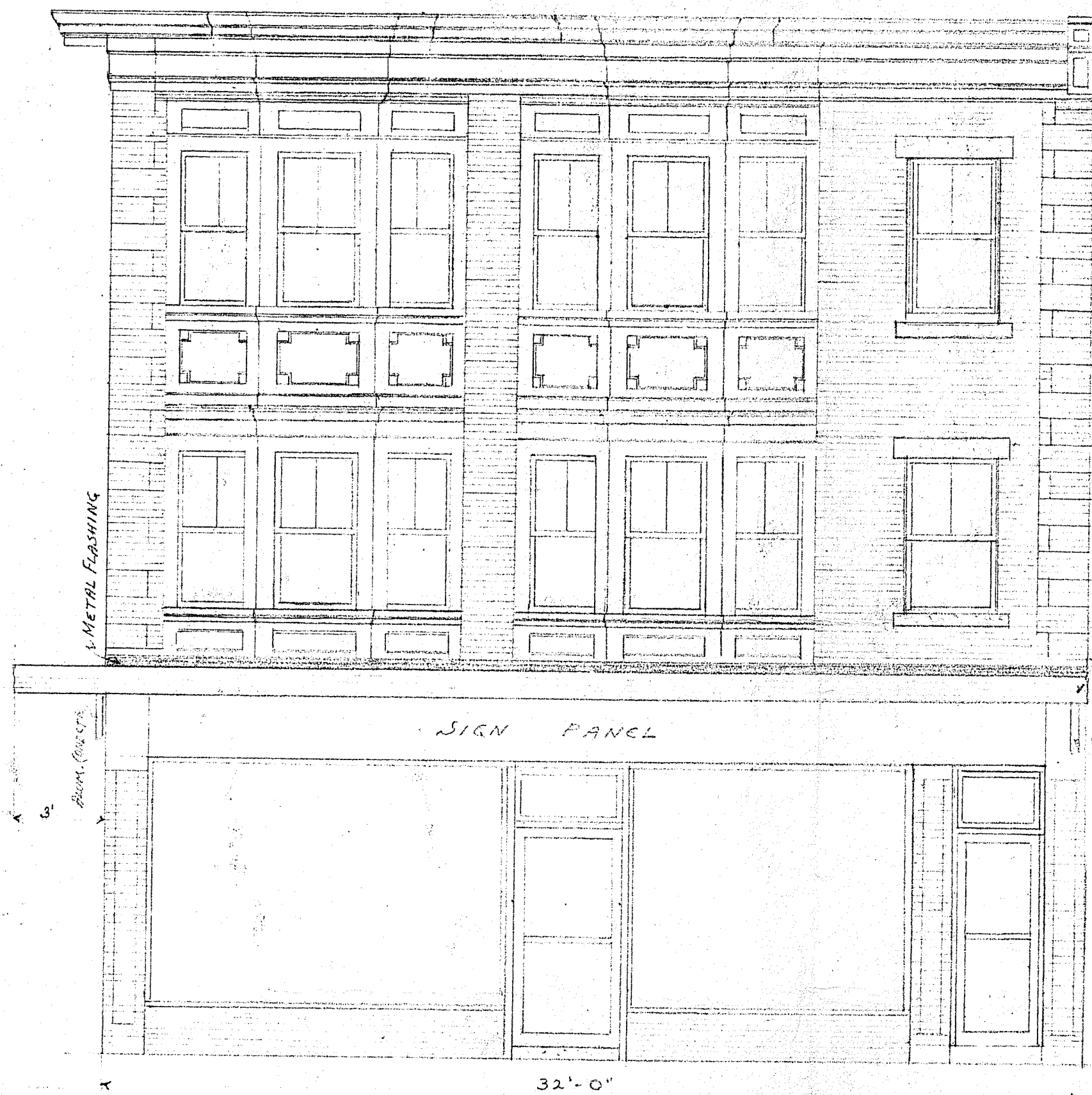
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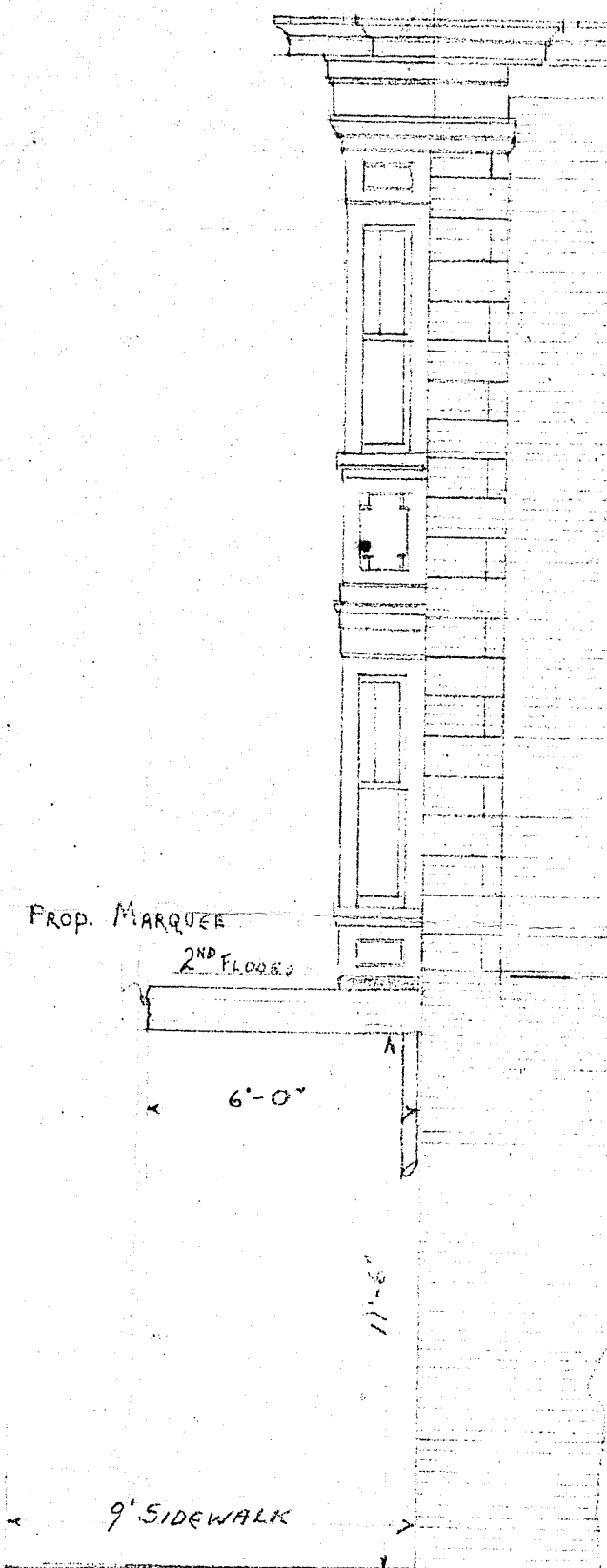

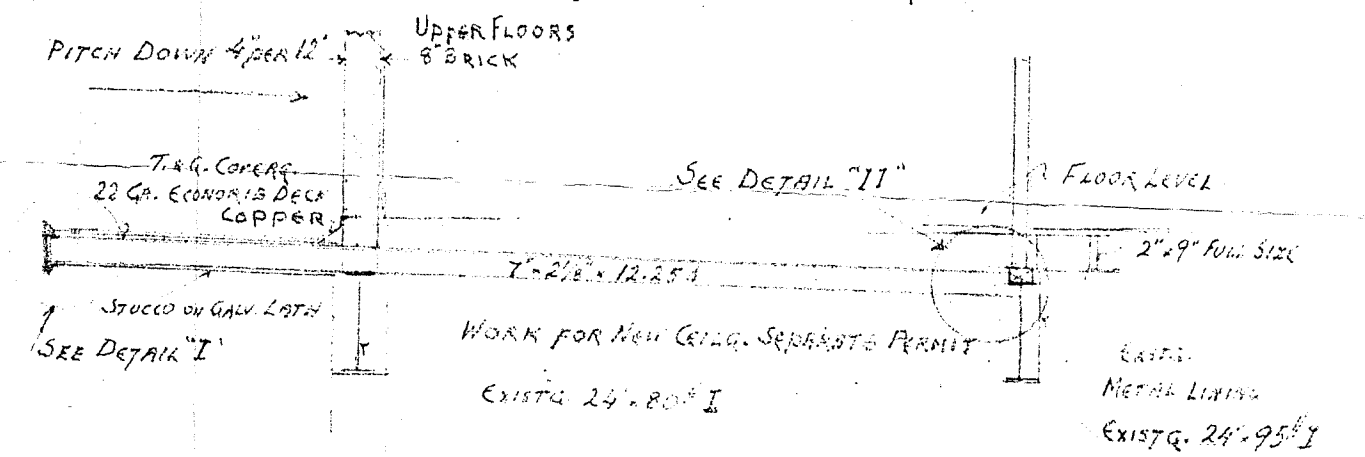
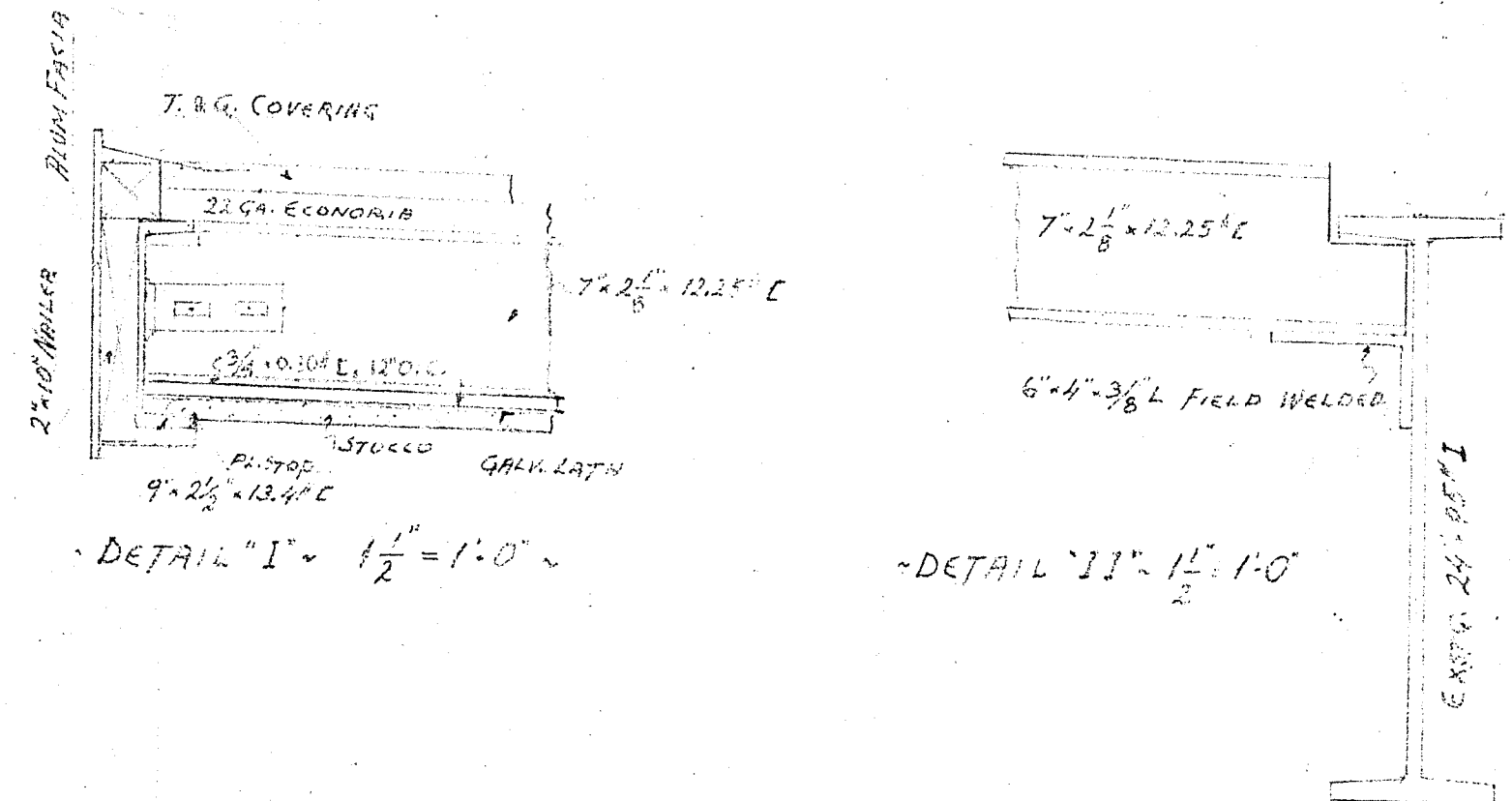




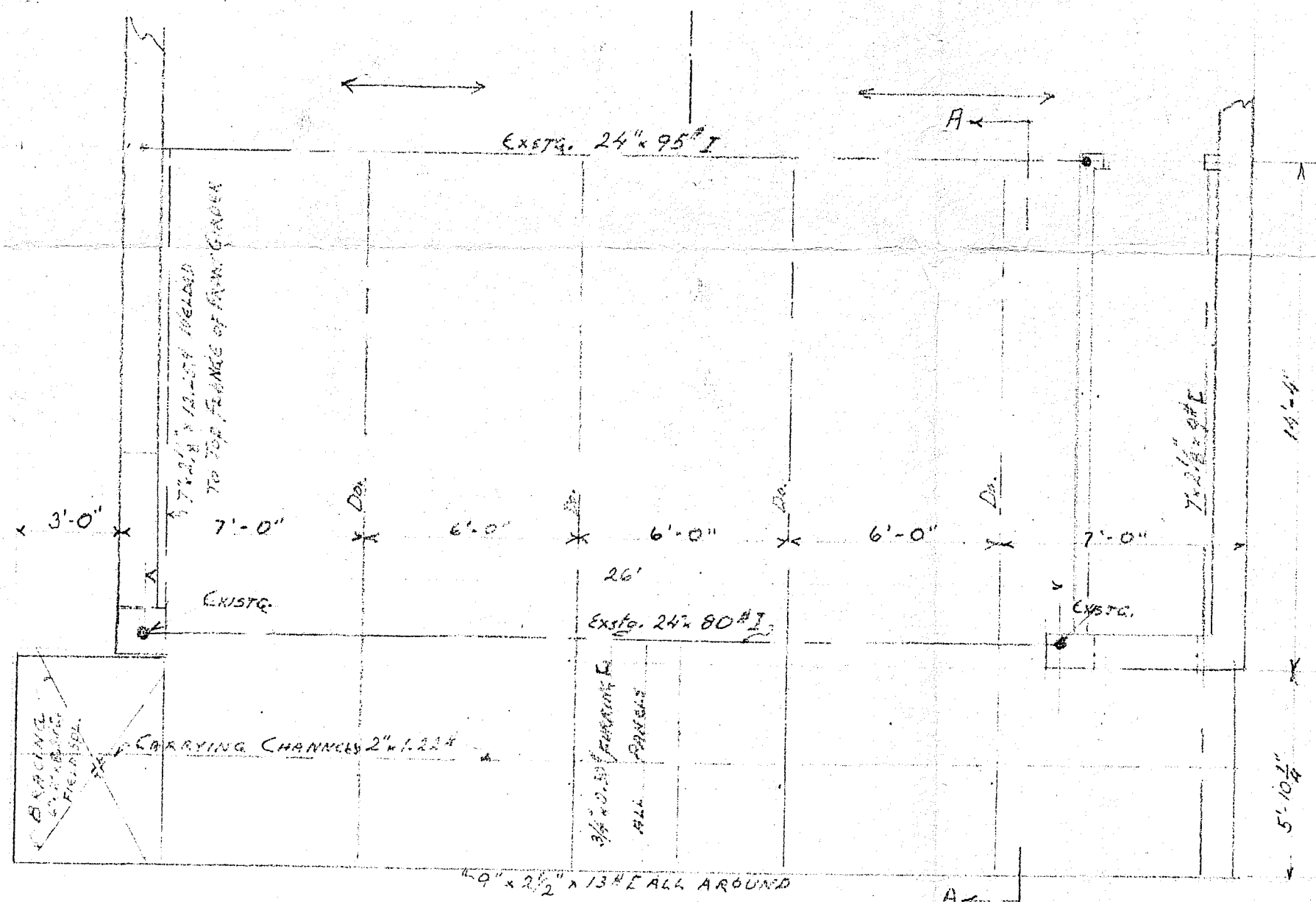
~ FRONT ELEVATION ~  $\frac{1}{4}'' = 1'-0''$



~ RIGHT ELEVATION ~  $\frac{1}{4}'' = 1'-0''$

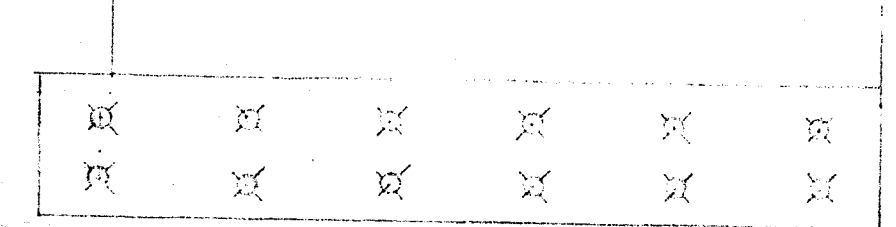
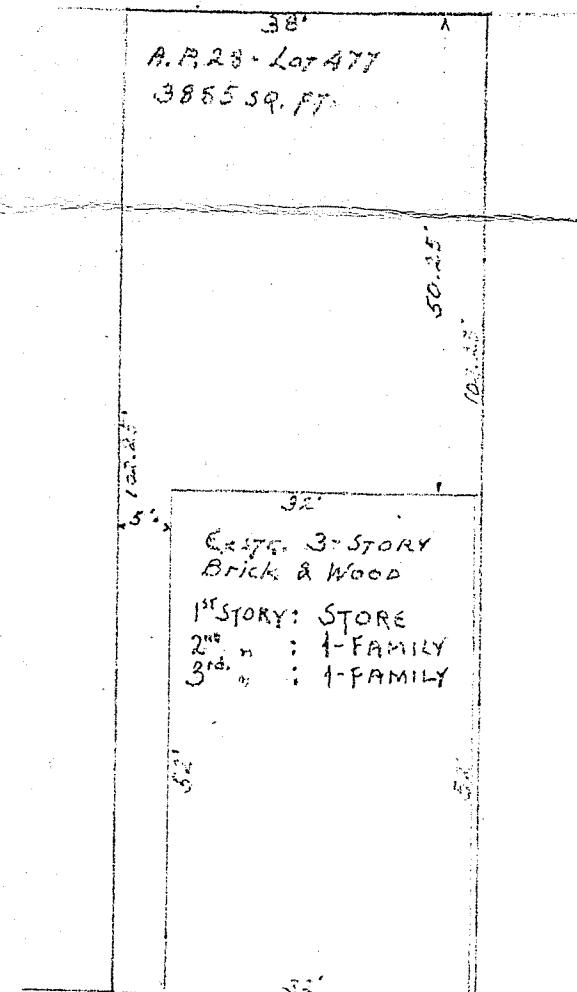


~ SECTION 'A-A' ~  $\frac{1}{4}'' = 1'-0''$

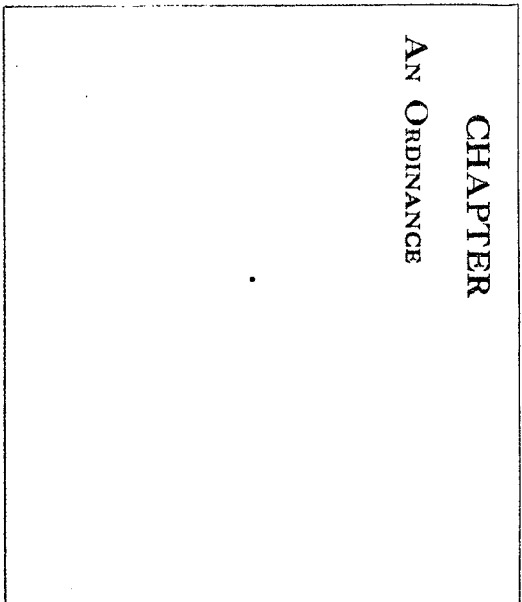

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 261

Approved April 19, 1963

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 3, approved January 3, 1961, the City Council of the City of Providence has approved filing by the Providence Redevelopment Agency for concurrence by the Housing and Home Finance Administration for the East Side Renewal Project; and

WHEREAS, said Project Area has been designated as East Side Renewal Project No. R. I. R-4; and

WHEREAS, the East Side Renewal Project No. R. I. R-4 has been recognized by the Housing and Home Finance Administration; and

WHEREAS, the Providence Redevelopment Agency is desirous of undertaking certain early land acquisition activities together with the necessary demolition and site clearance in connection therewith with respect to that certain area of land owned by the City of Providence in said Project Area; and

WHEREAS, the Providence Redevelopment Agency will file a request with the Federal Government for the issuance of a "Letter of Consent" for early land acquisition, it is recognized that the issuance of said "Letter of Consent" for early land acquisition activities does not constitute a commitment that the Federal Government must actually provide funds for carrying out the project, but the issuance of said "Letter of Consent" will enable the Providence Redevelopment Agency to carry out the activities involved and to claim credit for such activities when and if the project enters the formal execution stage.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY the City Council of the City of Providence as follows:

Section 1. That the Providence Redevelopment Agency is hereby authorized to undertake early land acquisition activities with respect to that certain area of land owned by the City of Providence, which said area of land is described as lot 471 on Assessor's Plat 16 shown on the records of the Tax Assessor of the City of Providence, which said area of land is within the East Side Renewal Project, R. I. R-4 and to carry out the necessary demolition and site clearance, in connection with said area of land proposed to be acquired by the Providence Redevelopment Agency.

Section 2. That the Providence Redevelopment Agency is further authorized to negotiate with the City of Providence for the determination of the value of said area of land proposed to be acquired.
