IN AMENDMENT OF SECTION 6.3 OF THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE
ENTITLED "GENERAL POWERS AND DUTIES OF FINANCE DIRECTOR."

SECTION 1. Section 6.3 of the Charter of the City of Providence
entitled "General Powers and duties of finance director," is hereby
amended to read as follows:

"Sec. 6.3 General powers and duties of finance director.

"The finance director shall have charge of the administration of
the financial affairs of the city as provided in this Act (chapter), and
to that end he shall have the authority and shall be required to super-
vise and be responsible generally and specifically:

- (a) Equipment and supplies. For purchasing, storing and disposing
of all equipment and supplies;
- (b) Assessing, collecting and disbursing money. For assessing,
collecting and authorizing the disbursement of all moneys due
or belonging to the city;
- (c) Preparing and administering budget. For preparing and admin-
istering the annual budget;
- (d) Employment of personnel. For administering and executing such
responsibilities relating to the employment of personnel as may
be prescribed by ordinance;
- (e) Accounting and reporting transactions. For accounting and
reporting of all financial transactions.
- (f) Treasurer. He shall have and exercise all powers and duties
that were vested in the office of city treasurer and all powers
and duties that may hereafter be vested in said office by law,
resolution or ordinance."

IN AMENDMENT OF SECTION 6.9 OF THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE
ENTITLED "APPOINTMENT, POWERS, DUTIES OF CITY ASSESSOR."

SECTION 1. Section 6.9 of the Charter of the City of Providence
entitled "Appointment, powers, duties of city assessor," is hereby amended
to read as follows:

"Sec. 6.9. Appointment, powers, duties of city assessor.

"The head of the assessment division shall be the city assessor who
shall be appointed by the finance director ~~subject-to-the-approval-of-the~~
~~city-council~~. The city assessor shall exercise and perform the powers and
duties now or heretofore vested in the board of tax assessors and the
chairman thereof."

SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect upon its passage and all acts
or parts of acts inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
