WHEREAS, Kathy officially retired from the City of Providence on January 30<sup>th</sup>, 2015 after many years of dedicated service; and



WHEREAS, Her diligence, positive attitude, professionalism, and charitable nature made Kathy an indispensable staff member and a beloved colleague.
