~~Be it ordained by the City of Providence:~~

WHEREAS, the Providence Community Action Program, Inc. the anti-poverty agency of the City of Providence, is the grantee for federal and state allocations for the support of the poor of our City, and

WHEREAS, the citizenry of the City of Providence directly benefits from the programs sponsored through the Providence Community Action Program, Inc., and

WHEREAS, the City of Providence is required to commit local resources to supplement federal and state allocations to the local anti-poverty program,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE, that the City Council appropriate the Principal and Interest of the Fund known as "City of Providence - Unclaimed Estates" (5-392) on deposit in the Citizens Savings Bank to the Providence Community Action Program, Inc.; the balance of the unused portion of the money allocated for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1979 shall revert to the General Fund of the City of Providence.
