### AN ACT

IN AMENDMENT OF SECTION 9(b) OF THE RETIREMENT ACT OF THE  
CITY OF PROVIDENCE, ENTITLED "BENEFITS PAYABLE."

*It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:*

SECTION 1: Section 9(b) of the Retirement Act of the City of Providence, entitled "Benefits Payable", is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Each Class B member who has attained the age of fifty-five, and each Class B member who attains the age of fifty-five, shall be retired forthwith, or on the first day of the calendar month next succeeding that in which the said member shall have attained the age of fifty-five years.

"Any Class B member, who on June 1, 1973 has attained the age of fifty-five years may continue in service for a period of three (3) years; but in no event after the first day of the calendar month next succeeding that in which he shall have attained the age of fifty-eight years."

SEC. 2. This Act shall take effect upon its passage and all acts or parts of acts inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
