RESOLVED, DECREED, AND ORDERED:

That the following named street shown as cross-hatched area on the accompanying plan entitled, "Providence, Rhode Island, Department of Public Works - Engineering Office, Street Line Section Plan No. 064124, dated June 6, 1980",

viz:

Sharon Street (portion of) a thirty foot portion, with adjoining sidewalks, approximately 500 square feet more or less at the intersection of Sharon and Smith Streets, shown as cross-hatched area on accompanying plan and designated by the letters (A-B-C-D-A) having ceased to be useful to the public and is proposed to be abandoned as Public Highway.

ORDERED, That the Director of Public Works be and he is hereby directed to cause a sign to be placed on the above-named highway abandoned as aforesaid, having thereon the words, "Not a Public Highway", and it is further

ORDERED, That after the entry of this order or decree the City Clerk shall cause a notice thereof to be published in a newspaper published in the City of Providence at least once a week for three successive weeks and a further and personal notice shall be served by the City Sergeant upon every owner of land abutting the above-named highway which has been abandoned, who is known to reside within the State.



The undersigned respectfully petitions your honorable body

For the abandonment of a 30 foot portion of Sharon Street with adjoining sidewalks, that property located on the northerly side of Smith Street and found on Plats 85 and 81, and adjacent to lots 16, 17, and 18 on that plat entitled, "Fairlawn Plat of Land belonging to the Estate of Phebe Allen as surveyed platted and drawn January, 1887 by C. E. Paine" a copy of which plat is recorded in the office of the Recorder of Deeds for the City of Providence on Plat Card 587, that portion of street described as follows:



Subject: Referral No. 2024 - Abandonment of Portion of Sharon Street

Gentlemen:

The City Plan Commission at its February 26, 1980 regular monthly meeting evaluated the subject petition proposing the abandonment of that portion of Sharon Street from Smith Street running northerly thirty feet (30') along the easterly side of Sharon Street. The petition was submitted by Mr. Vito D. Buonomano, who owns Lot 39 in A.P.81 which adjoins the easterly side of that portion of Sharon Street in question.


A field inspection revealed that portion of Sharon Street in question is an unimproved street and is used as part of the Smith Street playground which contains a playlot, tennis court, basketball courts, baseball field, picnic tables and benches. Part of the chain link fence for the playground is located at the portion of the street in question. A recently built residential structure with a garage is located on Lot 39. The surrounding area is within the R-1 Single Family Zone.

The street area proposed to be abandoned is very small, approximately 760 sq. ft. at the intersection of Sharon and Smith Streets. If this street area were abandoned, it will preclude the possibility of Sharon Street becoming a through street in the future. Therefore,


