Gentlemen:

At the request of a petition to the City Council, the Traffic Engineering Department has studied the advisability of installing STOP signs at the intersection of Ethan Street and Moorefield Street.

During the three-year period from August 1, 1950 to July 31, 1953, only one accident has been reported at this intersection.

Since there is only a short distance between this intersection and the intersection of Moorefield Street with Silver Lake Avenue, we feel at the present time it would be more advantageous to traffic to STOP Moorefield Street at Silver Lake Avenue instead of at Ethan Street. Therefore, STOP signs shall be erected at Moorefield Street and Silver Lake Avenue in the very near future.

After this installation has been completed, we will again study the intersection of Ethan Street and Moorefield Street with the advisability of STOP control.
