

In reference to the resolution of the Council dated November 21, 1958, investigations of the intersections of Colonial, Dexterdale, Edgehill, and Memorial roads at intersections with Camp Street have been investigated to determine the need for Boulevard Stop Signs or Yield Signs.

From the investigation of the accident history over the past eight years and the volume of traffic using these streets, it is felt that intersection control is not warranted at this time.





Because of the very low volume of traffic using this intersection and the relatively good accident history over the past eight years, we feel Traffic Control is not warranted at this time.


