Wriston/Keeney Quad Areas:


George Street one-way east from Brown Street to Thayer Street

Post and enforce "NO PARKING/EMERGENCY TOW ZONE" on the west side of Magee Street from George Street to Benevolent Street.



Dear Mr. Clarkin:

The end of the school year will see students moving out of their dormitories on Saturday, May 16, 1998.

With the majority of students leaving on Saturday, I am requesting approval for the following traffic pattern and posting on this date to deal with congestion around the University area:

Wriston/Keeney Quad Areas:

1. George Street one-way east from Brown Street to Thayer Street
2. Charlesfield Street one-way west from Thayer to Brown Street
3. Benevolent Street one-way east from Magee to Brown Street
4. Brown Street one-way north from Charlesfield to George Street
5. Post and enforce "NO PARKING/EMERGENCY TOW ZONE" on the west side of Magee Street from George to Benevolent St.

This traffic pattern should be established by 0600 on Saturday, May 16 and end by 1700 on that day. In addition, we are requesting that Providence Police relax tagging on this day in the University area.
