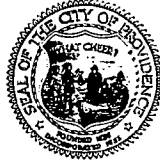

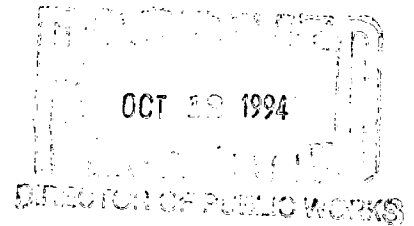


Dear Councilwoman Young:
