In accordance with the Provisions of Section 406 of the Providence Home Rule Charter of 1980 and Rule 3 of the Rules of the City Council, I am, this day, calling a Special Meeting of the City Council to be held on Monday, June 9, 2014 at 6:00 o'clock P.M., in the City Council Chamber, Third Floor, City Hall, for the purpose of acting upon the following:
