

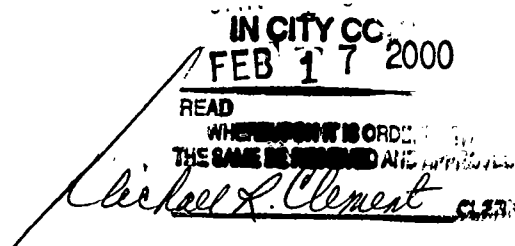
Dear Honorable Members:

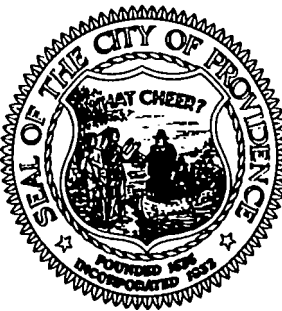


