The Traffic Engineering Department has received the above resolution from your Committee and has taken the subsequent action:

Request: That Hillhurst Avenue, in an easterly direction, from Pocasset Avenue to Laurel Hill Avenue, be established as a one way street.

Disposition: A traffic survey of this area has shown that there are no traffic warrants for the establishment of a one way street. A work order has been issued to replace several missing traffic regulations along this street. This should help ease the problem.
