AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE ZONING ORDINANCE CHAPTER 1994-24, NO. 365, APPROVED JUNE 27, 1994, AS AMENDED, BY EXPANDING THE REQUIREMENTS OF FOOTNOTE 2 FOR USE CODE 37, As Amended

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

SECTION 1. Whereas the First Amendment rights of all persons are to be recognized and protected; and

Whereas, the City has adopted a Comprehensive Plan; and

Whereas, the Comprehensive Plan has identified the adverse impact of adult entertainment on the citizens of the City of Providence.

SECTION 2. The Providence Zoning Ordinance Chapter 1994-24 No. 365, approved June 27, 1994, as amended, shall be further amended as follows:

a.) Section 303- Table use Regulations - Use Code 37 Footnote Number 2 is amended so as to read as follows:

"2. Provided that such uses shall be located more than 500 feet from any residential (Use Codes 11 through 17), religious service (Use Code 23), educational institution (Use Codes 21 and 21.1), park, recreation or open space (Use Code 33 through 36), and Library (Use Code 31) uses. In addition, any new adult entertainment uses shall be located not less than 2,000 feet from an existing adult entertainment use. A variance from these requirements shall be considered a use variance."

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage.

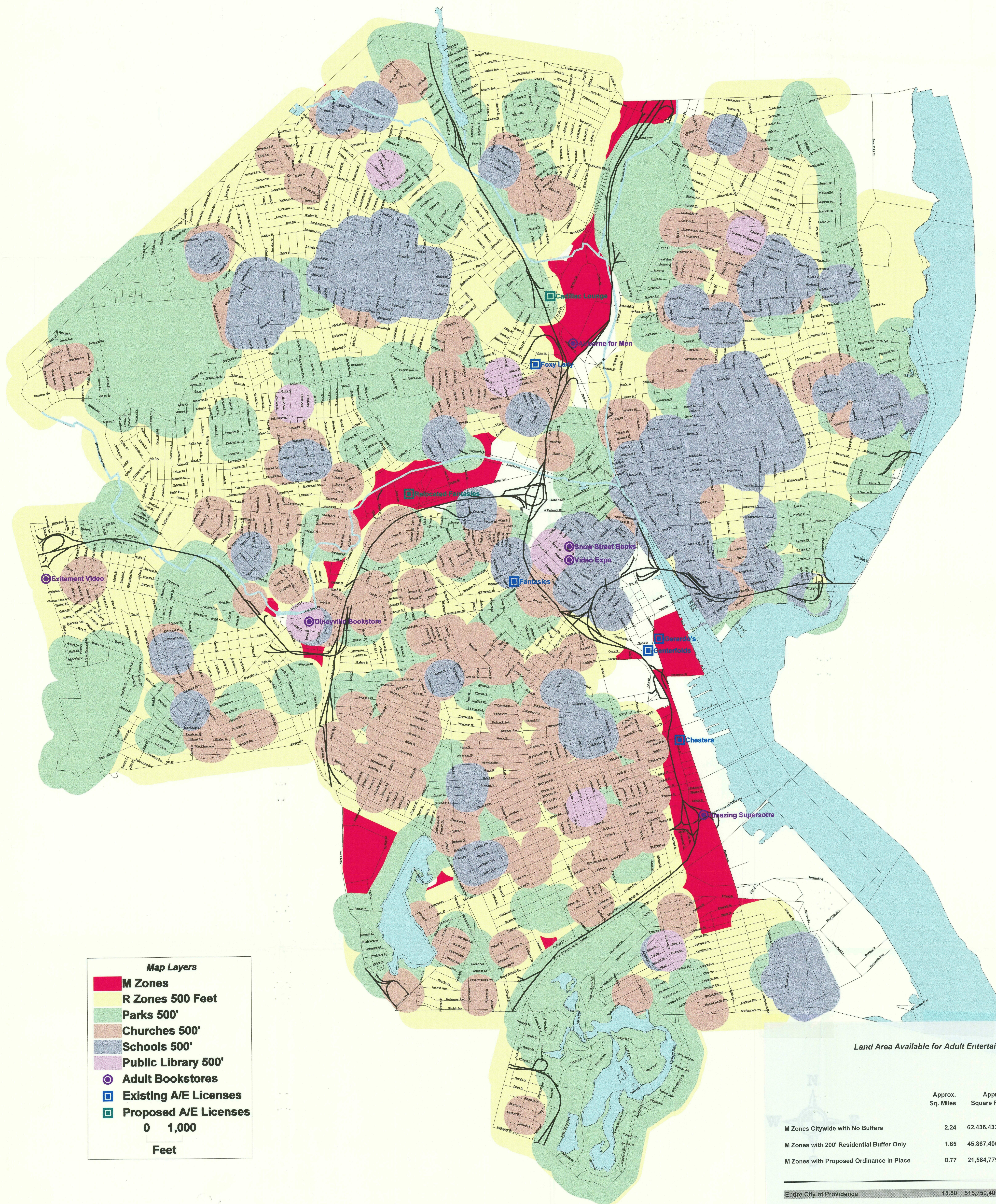
