The residents of the block of Hidden Street between Prospect and Congdon Streets are in the process of planning improvements to their sidewalks to make them safer and more attractive, and in connection with those improvements we would very much like the city to install curbs. Right now the edges of the street are poorly defined and highly unattractive, and in addition there is a problem of water draining improperly from the south side of the street into the basements of the homes on the north (lower) side of the street instead of into the storm drains. The owner of 5 Hidden Street has had water in her basement for the first time in 50 years.


