A TRAFFIC ENGINEERING DEPARTMENT AND PROVIDING FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF A
TRAFFIC ENGINEER".

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

SECTION 1. Section 1 of Chapter 163 of the Ordinances approved October 21, 1948, as heretofore amended, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

Section 1. As soon as may be after the passage of this amendment, the Mayor shall appoint, subject to the approval of the City Council, a qualified Traffic Engineer to serve as the head of the Traffic Engineering Department. The Traffic Engineer so appointed shall hold office until the first Monday in January, A. D. 1955 or until his successor is appointed and qualified. On the first Monday in January, A. D. 1955 or as soon thereafter as may be convenient, and every second year thereafter, the Mayor shall appoint, subject to the approval of the City Council, a Traffic Engineer for the term of two years. Any vacancy occurring in the office of Traffic Engineer shall be filled in like manner by appointment by the Mayor, subject to the approval of the City Council.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and all ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

DOLLARS TO AN ACCOUNT TO BE KNOWN AS "SPECIAL SEWER CONSTRUCTION
ACCOUNT".

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

SECTION 1: Chapter 776 of the Ordinances of the City of Providence as approved September 18, 1953, entitled: "An Ordinance Making Appropriation of \$29,679,752.90 for the Support of the City Government for the Fiscal Year Ending September 30, 1954", as amended, is hereby further amended by appropriating the sum of Forty Thousand (\$40,000) Dollars to an account to be known as "SPECIAL SEWER CONSTRUCTION ACCOUNT".

SECTION 2: The said sum of Forty Thousand (\$40,000) Dollars shall be obtained by transferring from the following accounts:

SEWER MAINTENANCE and CONSTRUCTION SECTION - ITEM 0 - \$10,000.
HIGHWAY SECTION - - - - - ITEM 0 - \$15,000.
STREET LIGHTING SECTION - - - - - ITEM 1 - \$15,000.

SECTION 3: The City Controller and the City Treasurer are hereby authorized and directed to pay over this appropriation from the General Fund to an account in the Capital Fund to be known as "SPECIAL SEWER CONSTRUCTION ACCOUNT". Any unexpended balance remaining in this account at the completion of this work shall revert to the General Fund.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.
