

reach the fountain.

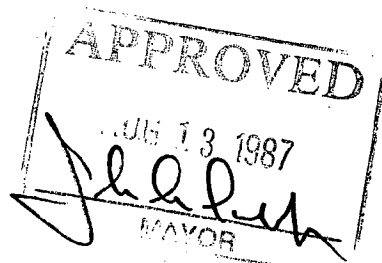

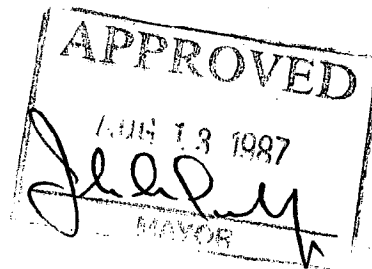

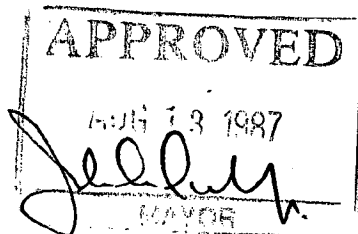
