EMERGENCY
AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE COMPENSATION PLAN
FOR THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE, AS AMENDED, ADJUSTING
THE BASE SALARY OF MEMBERS OF THE BARGAINING UNIT
OF THE FRATERNAL ORDER OF POLICE, LODGE NO. 3.

Approved February 12, 1976

WHEREAS, for the purpose of implementing the adjusted base salary of Members of the Bargaining Unit of the Fraternal Order of Police, Lodge No. 3; pursuant to Sec. 3.18 of the Charter of the City of Providence, it is hereby declared that in order to insure those Members who qualify for salary adjustments that they not be unduly inconvenienced with additional delay, it is hereby declared that an emergency situation exists.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE:

SECTION 1. Sec. 1 of the Ordinance of the City of Providence, as Amended is hereby further Amended as Follows:

1) Captain	\$275.50	\$280.50	Weekly
2) Lieutenant	\$255.70	\$260.70	Weekly
3) Sergeant	\$240.00	\$245.00	Weekly
4) Patrolman (After 18 months service)	\$215.00	\$220.00	Weekly
Patrolman (After 12 months service)	\$198.00	\$203.00	Weekly
5) Patrolman (Upon appointment)	\$193.00	\$198.00	Weekly

SECTION 2. This Emergency Ordinance shall take effect upon its adoption by the Council and its Approval by the Mayor, in accordance with the provisions of Sec. 3.18 of the said Charter, and shall be retroactive to July 1, 1975.
