That the following portion of named street as shown as cross-hatched area on the accompanying Plan entitled, Providence, R.I., P.W. Dept. - Engineering Office, Street Line Section, Plan No. 063970, dated May 28, 1976",

viz:

Portion of Jordan Street from its point of Intersection with Reservoir Avenue in a northwesterly direction along the north-erly side of the State Highway Line Amended Plat No. 1018 a distance of 482 feet, more or less, to the easterly side of said State Freeway Line Amended Plat No. 1018; and thence easterly along said State Freeway Line as Amended a distance of 232.86 feet, more or less, depicted on the above noted and accompanying plan as cross-hatched area, having ceased to be useful to the public and the same is proposed to be abandoned as a public highway, subject to any easements required by the Water Supply Board and of any private utility, and the damage to the abutters is appraised at nothing and so awarded, and it is further

ORDERED, that the Director of Public Works, be and he is hereby directed to cause a sign to be placed on the above-named highway abandoned as aforesaid, having thereon the words, "Not a Public Highway", and it is further

ORDERED, that after the entry of this order or decree, the City Clerk shall cause a notice, thereof, to be published in a newspaper published in the County of Providence at least once a week for three successive weeks, and a further and personal notice shall be served by the City Sergeant upon every owner of land abutting the above-named highway which has been abandoned, who is known to reside within the State.

On May 24, 1976 this department received a memorandum from the City Clerk along with a Petition to abandon a portion of Jordan Street.



SUBJECT: Referral No. 1945 - ABANDONMENT OF JORDON ST.(Portion)

Gentlemen:

This petition from the Committee on Public Works proposes the abandonment of Jordon St. on Plat 126 which runs in a generally north-westerly direction for a distance of 482 feet from 401 Reservoir Ave. to a dead-end and an entrance to an adjacent cemetery.

Inspection revealed that Jordon Street is a gravel surfaced trail which is bounded on one side by state land (Huntington Expressway) and on the other side by the Congregation Sons of Israel and David Cemetery.


Since the subject street serves no purpose other than as an entrance-exit for the cemetery and since the owners of the cemetery are the petitioners, the department is aware of no reason why the street should not be abandoned to the adjacent property owners.

Therefore, no objection is offered from a planning standpoint in the granting of the petition.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS

that, [REDACTED], a limited partnership created under the laws of the State of Rhode Island, and having its principal offices in the City of Warwick, Rhode Island (hereinafter called the Grantor), for consideration paid, grant to THE NARRAGANSETT ELECTRIC COMPANY, a Rhode Island corporation (hereinafter called the Grantee), its successors and assigns, but without covenants, the right and easement to maintain and operate, for the distribution of electric current, an existing line of poles, with the necessary wires, cables, anchors, guys, equipment and appurtenances attached thereto, over, across and upon that portion of the Grantor's land located in the City of [REDACTED], County of [REDACTED], State of Rhode Island being that section of [REDACTED] abandoned by the City of Warwick and acquired by the Grantor by virtue of Resolution No. [REDACTED] 265 of the City Council of the City of [REDACTED] approved [REDACTED], 1970.

Also the right and easement from time to time to clear and keep cleared said line of poles of trees, underbrush and structures as necessary for the safe and proper operation of said line of poles, and to renew, replace, add to and otherwise change said line of poles, and each and every part thereof, but not the general location thereof, and to pass over and across the Grantor's said land to and from said line of poles as reasonable and necessary for all of the above purposes.

It is agreed that said line of poles shall remain the property of the Grantee, its successors and assigns, and that the Grantee, its successors and assigns, shall pay all taxes assessed thereon.


