RE: PENDING RESOLUTION BEFORE COMMITTEE

Request: To establish a four-way stop control at the intersection of Dudley Street and Prairie Avenue.

Disposition: Granted. This department has concluded its study of the accident history of this intersection and has determined that a four-way stop control is warranted at this time. We will also be contacting the State Traffic Commission to review our accident statistics to see if Federal Funding is available under the "High Hazard" program to install new or upgranted traffic signals where warranted.
