

December 19, 2011 Agenda Items (Cont'd)

15.	<b>Resolution Requesting the Traffic Engineer to cause the installation of "Four-Way Stop" Signs at the intersection of Vermont Avenue and Virginia Avenue.</b>	Presently Vermont STOPS at Virginia. Virginia STOPS one block to the south at Washington Ave and four blocks to the north at New York. A four way STOP will be created.
16.	<b>Resolution Requesting the Traffic Engineer to cause the installation of the missing "No Right Turn on Red" Sign heading west on Eaton Street to River Avenue.</b>	Work Order 11-1158 was made and the work was completed on Dec. 20, 2011.
17.	<b>Resolution Requesting the Traffic Engineer to cause the inspection of Burnett Street from Elmwood Avenue to Public Street for the purpose of making it a one-way from Elmwood Avenue to Public Street.</b>	Due to the narrowness of the roadway (18 feet) and the sharp bend in this street, there is no objection to making this portion of Burnett St one-way.
