I am a resident of the ward that you represent. I live at 1536 Westminster Street at the intersection of Westminster Street, Sycamore Street, and Bainbridge Avenue. ~~At one corner of the intersection there is a group of stores; opposite the stores is my residence. The other corner has a gas station and an auto repair shop is located at the fourth corner.~~

At both the repair shop and gas station there are cars parked all night. We now have only one small street light covering the entire intersection. A bus stop, located in front of my house on Westminster Street also remains in darkness throughout the night.

Through your representation, I would like you to submit to the Council a request for an additional street light at this intersection. I am afraid to leave my house after darkness sets in since it is extremely dark in this area and I never know who is behind one of the parked cars. I know that people who must wait for a bus at night in front of my house also feel the same way.
