No. 2 **AN ORDINANCE** AMENDING THE APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE CHAPTER 1983-30 APPROVED JULY 10, 1983 BY TRANSFERRING THE SUM OF FORTY-FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$45,000.00) FROM MOTOR FUEL ACCOUNT (1-005-17-02-11) TO THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS MUNICIPAL DOCKS AND SERVICE ACCOUNT (1-05-13-151), AS AMENDED.

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

SECTION 1. Chapter 1983-30 of the Ordinances of the City of Providence, as approved July 10, 1983, entitled: "An Ordinance Making an Appropriation of One Hundred Sixty Nine Million, Seven Hundred Ninety-Six Thousand, Two Hundred Forty-Dollars and Ninety-Six Cents (\$169,796,240.96) for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1984, as amended", is hereby further amended by transferring the sum of Forty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$45,000.00) from Motor Fuel Account (1-005-17-02-11) to the Department of Public Works Municipal Docks and Service Account (1-05-13-151).

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its Passage.



Dear Councilwoman Brassil:

The Finance Department is requesting a transfer of \$45,000.00 within the 1983-1984 General Fund appropriation. This transfer would reduce Debt Service Retirement Bonds (1-12-01-802) \$45,000.00, while increasing the Municipal Dock Maintenance and Service account by the same amount.
