WHEREAS, there is a cause for great concern of all residents within the Smith Hill Area having experienced a prolonged period of vandalism and crime, and

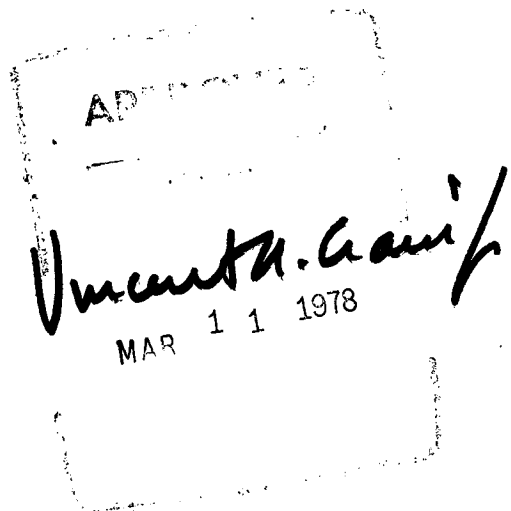
WHEREAS, the Installation of Lumen High Pressure Sodium Vapor Lights may deter crime in the Smith Hill section and other sections of our City,
