RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

Approved December 26, 1984

WHEREAS, with this thought in mind, and in light of the season of the year, we, the Providence City Council, respectfully request that the Honorable Mark White, Governor of the Sovereign State of Texas, see fit to intervene in the case of Mary Evelyn Mosqueda of Odessa, Texas,

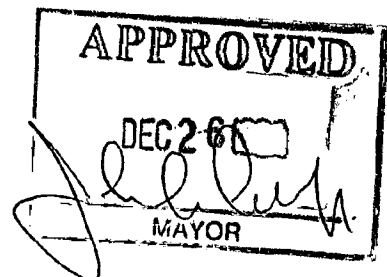
