P R O C L A M A T I O N

WHEREAS, Chapter 67 of the 1973 Rhode Island Public Laws entitled the Rhode Island Defense Civil Preparedness Act of 1973, as enacted, directs the establishment of a State Defense Civil Preparedness Agency and of local Defense Civil Preparedness Agencies, and

WHEREAS, said legislation directs that each Mayor of the State establish a local Defense Civil Preparedness Agency by Proclamation of the Mayor, and

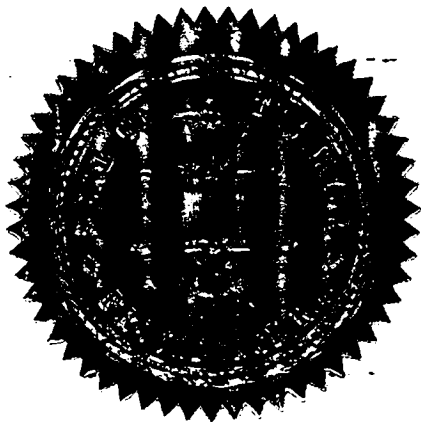
WHEREAS, the organization of the Providence Defense Civil Preparedness Agency is vitally important to the safeguarding of lives and property during times of emergency in this city, and

WHEREAS, the Rhode Island Defense Civil Preparedness Act provides for an Advisory Council for Defense Civil Preparedness. This Council is hereby established to consist of fifteen members appointed by and holding office during the pleasure of the Mayor. The purpose of this Council is to assist in the coordination of local activities relating to National, State and Local Defense Civil Preparedness.

NOW, THEREFORE, I Joseph A. Doorley, Jr., Mayor of Providence, do hereby proclaim that the Providence Defense Civil Preparedness Agency has been organized and established under the provisions of Section 30-15-12 of the above-cited act with the authority, duties, powers and responsibilities as outlined therein.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I, Joseph A. Doorley, Jr., Mayor of Providence have hereunto set my hand and caused my seal to be affixed this 14th day of June, A.D. 1973

SUBJECT: Civil Preparedness Agency

The 1973 Civil Preparedness Act requires a proclamation of the Mayor to establish a comparable local agency to that established on the state level. Since the act provides for an Advisory Council for Civil Defense Preparedness, the State Council is composed of 17 members who serve at the pleasure of the Governor.

Our local Advisory Council could be patterned after the State. Membership could be allocated as follows:

A. 9 Ex-officio members

1. Mayor or his Designee
2. Commissioner of Public Safety
3. Chief of Police
4. City Solicitor
5. Chief of Fire Department
6. Director of Public Works
7. Administrative Assistant to the Mayor
8. Superintendent of Providence schools or Designee
9. Director of Public Properties
10. Director of Communications
11. Director of Finances
12. Traffic Engineer
13. Medical Society Designee
14. Red Cross Designee
15. Salvation Army Designee
