

## PETITION TO THE CITY COUNCIL

**TO THE HONORABLE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE:**

*The undersigned respectfully petitions your honorable body*

Now comes the undersigned and petitions your honorable body to abandon Belden Street, being that street which runs parallel (on its north/south boundaries) to Hempstead Street and Longfellow Street, for approximately 275 feet, and perpendicular to Elmwood Avenue (on its easterly boundary) at numbers 819 and 809. Please see the attached "Exhibit A".

As grounds therefor, the Petitioner avers as follows:

1. That on the 17th day of February, 1988, the Petitioner executed a Purchase and Sale Agreement relative to all of the abutting City lots (except the railroad tracks) which are listed hereinbelow.
2. That he intends to construct multi-family dwelling units on said lots, 2, 15, 26, 27, 41, 43, 45, 60, 62, 63, 100, 130, 150 and 170 of Plat 60 as listed in the Providence Tax Assessor's office.
3. That each and every lot abutting said Belden Street, except the railroad tracks, will become part of said multi-family complex and, as such, will have access to Elmwood Avenue.
4. That the westerly boundary of Belden Street ends at the railroad tracks requiring no access from said boundary, said street being a dead end. Therefore, said street will cease to be useful to the public.
5. That there will be no damages sustained by the abutting owners since they have agreed to sell said abutting lots to your Petitioner subject to the approval by the Town Council of this Petition.

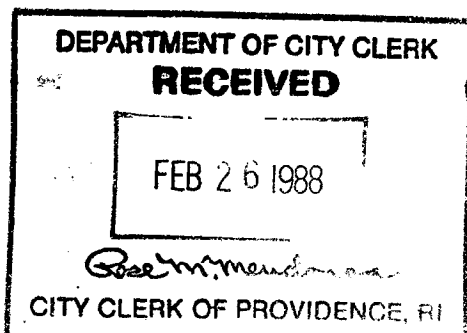


Dear Mr. Clement:

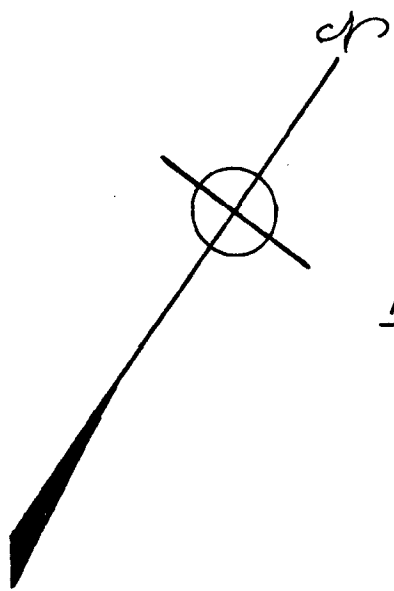

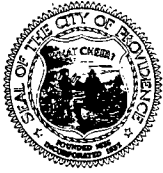

The Water Supply Board has no facilities in the area of East George Street to be abandoned and therefore has no objection to the abandonment of that portion of East George Street.


In regard to the request for the abandonment of Beldon Street, the applicant must agree to remove all active services and cap the water main.

One (1) 1 1/2" Service	\$ 33.09
Excavate, Cut, Plug, and Thrust Block; Material, Labor and Overhead	\$2,214.24
	<u>\$2,318.73</u>

We respectfully request that the petitioner be notified and that he agree to pay the Water Supply Board the sum of \$2,318.73 before final action is taken by your committee.


