

Via telephone conversations with the following police departments the following information was obtained:

I learned from Det. Lombardi, Cranston, P.D., that they had listed in their 1970 City Directory, one Harold B. Perlow, residing at #10 Rangley Rd, Tele#-942-9463. Occupation, Antique Dealer, Eddy St, our city. Wife's first name listed as Ruth E.


I then requested a confidential check in the neighborhood to confirm that Mr. Perlow was still living at 10 Rangley Rd., and it was learned that he still does.

A check was made with the Narragansett P.D., (Officer Robert Gilbert), and it was learned that the Perlow's had owned property at 35 Narragansett Ave, their town, not known if same is still owned by the Perlow's but felt same has been since sold.

Their voting list was checked and they could not find that Harold B. Perlow voted in 1968, but learned that a Ruth Perlow of above 35 Narragansett Ave, did vote in the year 1968 and 1970.

Our city directory reveals a Eddy St. Antiques at 1183 Eddy St, Tele#781-8740, business apparently operated by Mr. Perlow. A check was made with the Cranston Board of Canvassers, a Mr. A. Murray and it was learned that Harold & Ruth Perlow have never voted in their City.

DISPOSITION: By direction of Councilman Peter C. Moran, as Chairman of the Committee on Licenses, I submit the following to you for investigation:

Harold B. Perlow, Petition to the City Council for appointment as an Auctioneer, giving his residence as 120 Johnson Street, Providence, his date of birth as March 4, 1926, business address as 1183 Eddy Street.

On March 3, 1971, Gaetano Lanzi, as a member of the Board of Canvassers and Registration, certified that the subject petitioner qualified as an Elector of the City of Providence on March 3, 1971.

Personal inspection by Councilman Moran revealed that there is no structure at 120 Johnson Street and his further personal investigation leaves a question in his mind that the subject is in residency at Rangley Road, Cranston, Rhode Island, and further that he voted in the town of Narragansett in 1968.

Accordingly, may we have the benefit of the Police Department investigation on the above matters and a report from you in writing.
