WHEREAS, Providence recognizes strong families are at the center of strong community collaborations;


WHEREAS, Everyone has a role to play in making families successful, including neighborhood organizations, businesses, nonprofit agencies, policymakers and, of course families themselves;

WHEREAS, During Valentine's week we all should take time to honor the importance of collaboration, and recognize the special connections that support and strengthen our community year-round;


WHEREAS, We all recommit to enhancing and extending all of the collaboration that strengthen and enrich families;
