RESOLVED, That the Traffic Engineer is hereby requested to undertake a survey to determine the feasibility of allowing On-Street Parking twenty-four (24) hours a day, to be restricted to one side only of the streets of the City of Providence, except on those streets already permanently posted with parking regulations with the following stipulations:

When the month of December comes in the even-numbered years, on-street parking shall be restricted on all other streets of the City twenty-four (24) hours a day from December 1 in that even-numbered year to April 1 of the following year to the even-numbered sides of the streets.

When the month of December comes in the odd-numbered years, on-street parking shall be restricted on all other streets of the City twenty-four (24) hours a day from December 1 in that odd-numbered year to April 1 of the following year to the odd-numbered sides of those streets.

That Owners of Vehicles shall be required to remove their vehicles off streets designated snow routes by appropriate signs when snowfall shall have reached Two (2) Inches in depth.

Warnings that snowfall is probably to reach a depth of Two (2) Inches shall be timely issued by the Commissioner of Public Safety, or person or persons designated by him through the medium of the press, radio and television.

Vehicles parked in violation of the foregoing hereof shall be tagged and fined not exceeding Twenty (\$20.00) Dollars for each offense.
