

# RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

WHEREAS, the Pepsi Cola Company and WJB-105 are willing and able sponsors for the Mayor's Summertime Fund Skate Board Race to be held on Kennedy Plaza on May 12, 1979; and

WHEREAS, the proceeds from said Skate Board Race are to be donated to the Mayor's Summertime Fund; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor's Summertime Fund is a charitable organization which provides monies in order that neighborhood children may attend summer camp free of charge; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor's Summertime Fund is supported solely by donations and contributions, and maintains no alternative means of obtaining revenues for these worthy causes;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that in the spirit of cooperation on the part of the City of Providence to aid the Mayor's Summertime Fund and to work harmoniously with the Pepsi Cola Company and WJB-105 in this fund raising endeavor, the Traffic Engineer is requested to prohibit motor vehicle traffic in and along the Kennedy Plaza during the hours of 9:00 o'clock A.M. to 3:00 o'clock P.M. on Saturday, May 12, 1979 to accommodate the proposed Mayor's Summertime Fund Skate Board Race.
