RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

RESOLUTION APPROVING AND PROVIDING FOR THE EXECUTION OF A PROPOSED CONTRACT FOR A NEIGHBORHOOD FACILITIES GRANT PROJECT UNDER SECTION 703 OF THE HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT ACT OF 1965, AS AMENDED, NUMBERED CONTRACT NO. R.I. N-4(G), BY AND BETWEEN THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE AND THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA

WHEREAS, the United States of America (herein called the "Government") has tendered to the City of Providence (herein called the "Grantee") a proposed Contract for a Neighborhood Facilities Grant Project under Section 703 of the Housing and Urban Development Act of 1965, as amended, under which the Government would make an advance of Federal funds to the Grantee with respect to the Project designated Project No. R.I. N-4 at the location described in such proposed Contract; and

WHEREAS, the Grantee has given due consideration to said proposed Contract;

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE, RHODE ISLAND AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The proposed Contract for Neighborhood Facilities Grant under Section 703 of the Housing and Urban Development Act of 1965, as amended, designated Contract No. R.I. N-4(G), consisting of Parts 1 and 2, under and subject to the terms and conditions of which the Government would make a grant of Federal funds to the Grantee to aid in financing the cost of the project designated Project No. R.I. N-4, situated in the City of Providence, Rhode Island, is hereby in all respects approved.

Section 2. The Mayor of the Grantee is hereby authorized and directed to execute said proposed Contract in two counterparts on behalf of the Grantee, and the Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to impress and attest the official seal of the Grantee on each such counterpart and to forward such counterparts to the Department of Housing and Urban Development for execution on behalf of the Government, together with other documents relative to the approval and execution thereof as well as to this Resolution as may be required by the Government.

Section 3. The Mayor, is hereby authorized to file requisitions, together with necessary supporting documents, with the Government, from time to time as grant funds are required, requesting payments to be made on account of the grant provided for in the said Contract, and to do and perform all other things and acts required to be done or performed in order to obtain such payments.

Section 4. This Resolution shall take effect upon its passage.
