During the year of 1976, the Housing Board of Review held fourteen (14) meetings, five (5) of which were public hearings on appeals for exceptions under the Housing Ordinance and nine (9) of which were Executive Sessions.

Presented to the Board were thirteen (13) appeals, all of which were inspected by the Board on field trips. There were three cases continued at the request of Attorney's for the petitioners.
